





- 3) Single Sword


An entrance fee of \$1.00 will be levied on all fighters to defray costs.


By City Regulations, there can be no pavilions, dogs must be kept on a leash, DRY SITE (Sorry), and we must be out of the park by closing at 11 pm.

A PURSUERS GUIDE TO - TAVERNS & PUBLIC HOUSES - PART II by I.C. MOOR

THE SWORD HILT INN

Located in the far western reaches. This inn is worth a minimum of a day's rest (or longer). Located at the edge of the sea the Hilt is set high above a tranquil bay that provides a substantial amount of seafood for the dinner table. As the weather is mostly warm all year round local crops are harvested three times a year. The landlord and his wife are two of the finest cooks in the country. Crowned heads from everywhere gather here to feast and discuss the problems of rulers. As the landlord has become wealthy over the years he has a well armed, handpicked force of mercenaries that guard his lnads and protect him from invaders. The food is quite exceptional and the ale is beyond compare.

THE CARRION CRAWLER

A rather unusual name for a tavern. This may seem so until you make your first trip to the wind cellar. The tavern is located on the site of the long abandoned dungeons and crypts of the "old city of Deathmarch". The tunnels go on for miles and if you are either brave or foolish (your choice) you might try your luck at finding the "treasure" that is rumoured to be somewhere in the tunnels. A local legend states that the long dead King Dryco of Deathmarch consealed his treasure somewhere in the tunnels just prior to being slain by troops. The tavern's name comes from the flest eating beetles that hunt the tunens and haunt the crypts below the tavern.

THE PURPLE SPIDER

This is a unique place to stop. The food is palatable, but a bit too salty. The name is derived from the enormous Purple Spider that was slain here in the garden behind the inn. It had descended from the heavens to feast upon the local inhabitants. Fortunately enough for all concerned the wazard known only as "The DARSHAN" was partaking of a bit of ale when screams emmanated from outside of the then local tavern (The Swill). Being not well known in those parts (and seeing a great opportunity) The DARSHAN slowly moved into the open and gazed uponthe spider who was munching on the local sheriff and a few of his local troops. After gaining the spider's attention by staring intently at the creature he raised his arms. A brilliant bolt of lightning was brought forth from the stick that he carried and the blue flash penetrated the head of the spider and burned a gaping hole thru in seconds. The wizard was well paid for his deed and given a lifetime guarantee for shelter and free food and ale as long as he lived. The only thing that really bothers me is I can't get used to the "purple" colour of the local ale. It tastes fair but I keep wondering about it.
