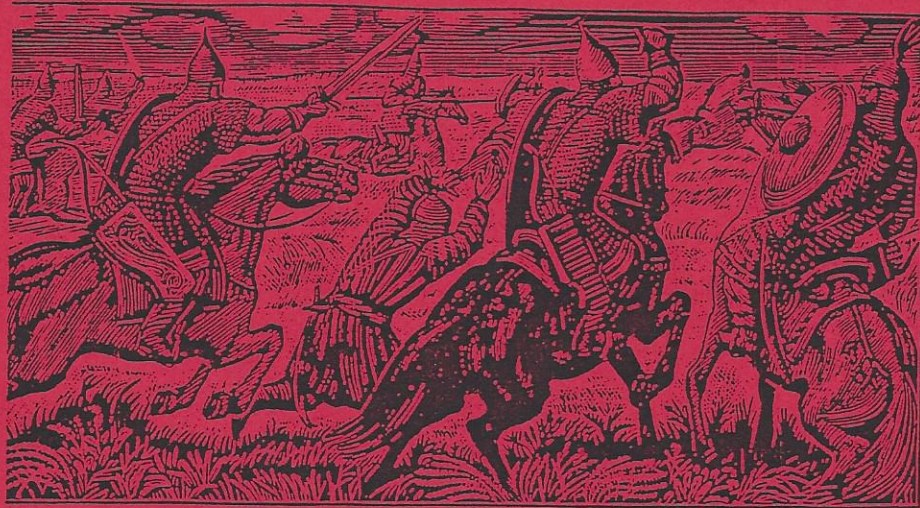

As promised, here is the next announcement on Coronation - So pray attend!

GENERAL INFORMATION:

There is no running water at Windhover Cliff (except for emergencies) and no building of fires. All pets need to be kept under control at all times as there are cattle on the property. Please bring banners to the Feast Hall - and yes the Feast Hall is a wet site (so is Windhover Cliff).

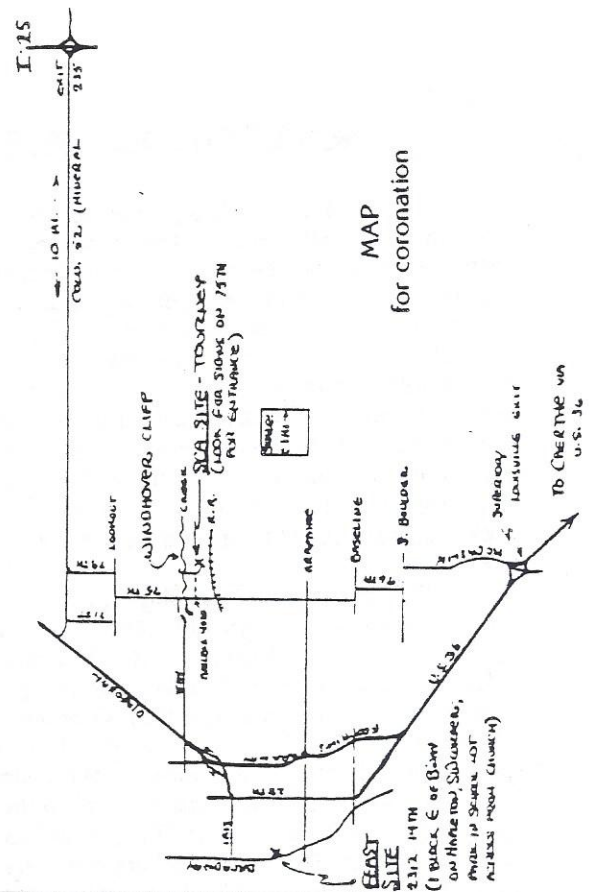
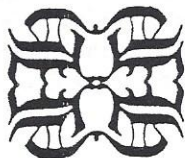

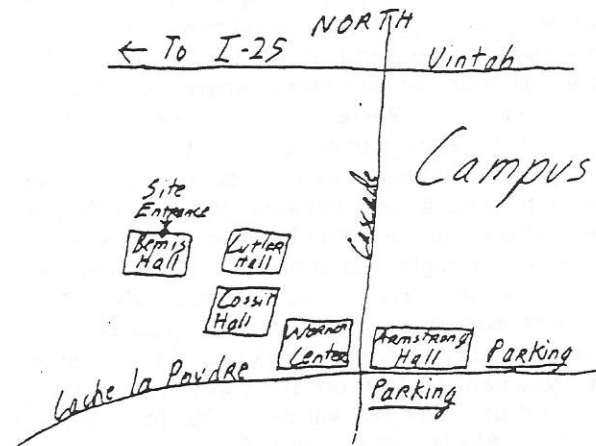
## FEAST OF FOOLS

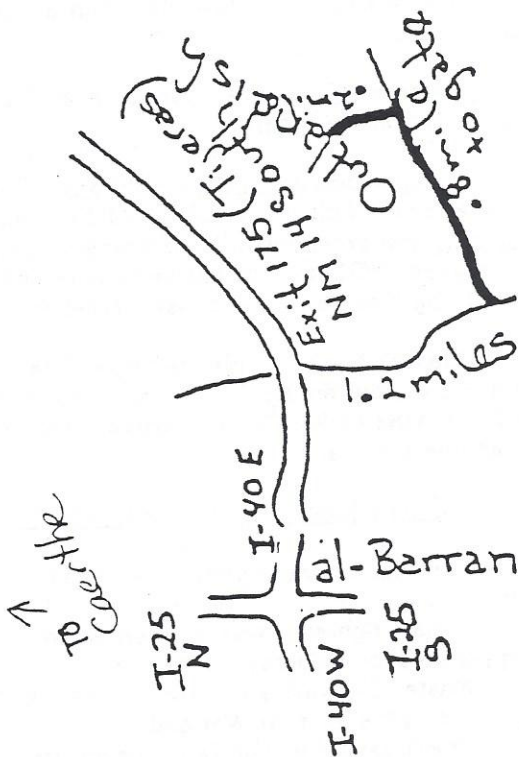

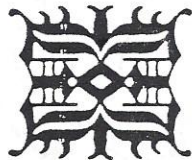
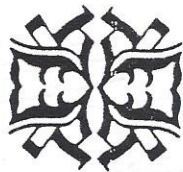
