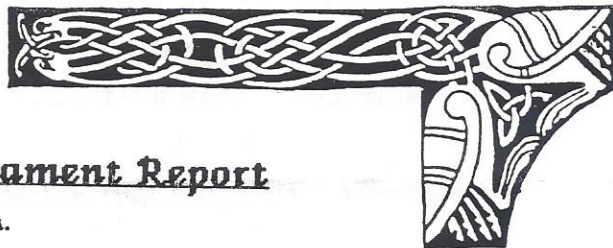

Fighters are in armor and have a medieval look about them but the rest of us can complete the look by slipping on a tunic or gown while we sit and watch the fighters. This simple thing will help attract new people and encourage newcomers to make and wear garb.

Crown Journey is just a little over a month away. Lady Aldith is still asking for servers and kitchen helpers, and I can still use people to help set up the site and work while Crown Journey is going on. People who help in these areas will have their site fees or feast fees waived respectively. This is a good way to cut your costs and still have a good time at the event. Unto all gentles who read this missive. Greetings.

Windkeep has been awarded the great honor of hosting the next Crown Journey on the weekend of October 5-6. When the decision to submit the bid for the event, there were many gentles who expressed a willingness to help, should it be awarded. Lady Aldith needs 20 servers and 10 scullery helpers. Those who wish to help in these capacities will enjoy the feast free of fee. Contact Lady Aldith immediately if you wish to help, because the call will go out to the Kingdom before the first of the month if the required number are not to be found in Windkeep. We will be able to serve 200 at the feast, and it will truly be no small undertaking. We also need to know immediately the exact number of people who have crash space and how many each gentle can have, so that Lord Rhys can assign people who need crash space to those who have. We want to accommodate as many as possible before having to acquire mundane accommodations. Bear in mind that if someone is coming up from Citadel, or Al-Barran, they may be here a day early and leave a day later than the event. We have A LOT of newbies, and many of them don't get the Windswept, or the O'H yet. Make a special effort to get the word to them at Armourers and Fletchers Guild, or Fighter practice, so that they can make it to populace meeting and get to work on their garb. This is truly a great time in the Shire of Windkeep.

In the event of inclement weather, the indoor site will be the gymnasium of Anderson Elementary School. The site will open at 8:00 a.m., with Court, armor inspection, and Crown Tournament occurring, at the Crown's discretion shortly thereafter. Crash space is limited but available. We have also contacted several hotels and motels in the area regarding discounted lodging. Please call the autocrat for arrangements. A feast will be held at First Christian Church, corner of 27th and Carey. Please refer to map for location and directions.

The feast site will open at 4:00 p.m. for set up, with the feast starting at 6:00 p.m. Please note that all sites are BONE DRY, no alcohol at all.

There will be a tournament on Sunday beginning 10:00 a.m. SCA time. The fees for the weekend are as follows: \$5.00 site fee and \$7.00 feast fee for a total of \$12.00. Smalls 3 - 12 are half price, and under 3 are free. The Feast will be limited to the the first 200 reservations. Those who wish to help with the feast of the tournament will have their fees adjusted. October 26 - 27, 1991

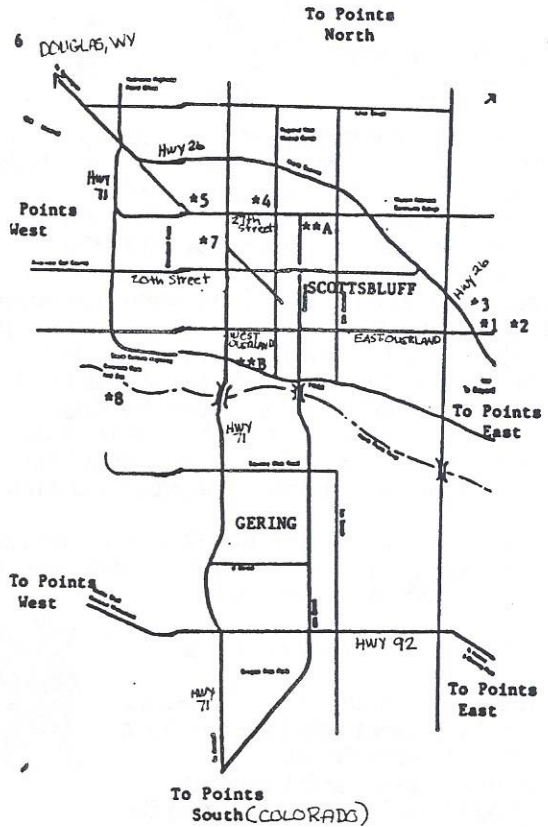
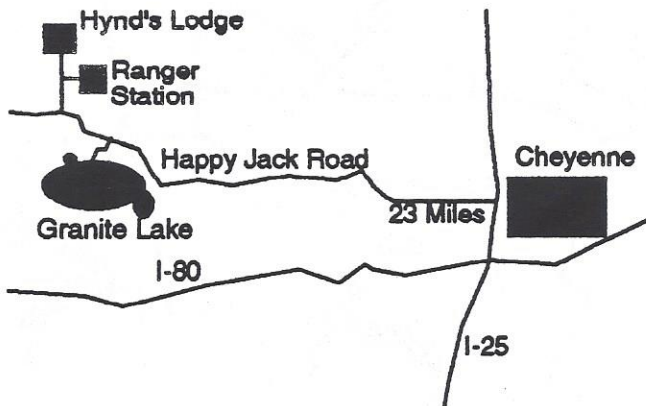

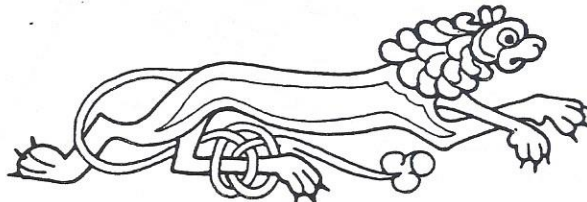
