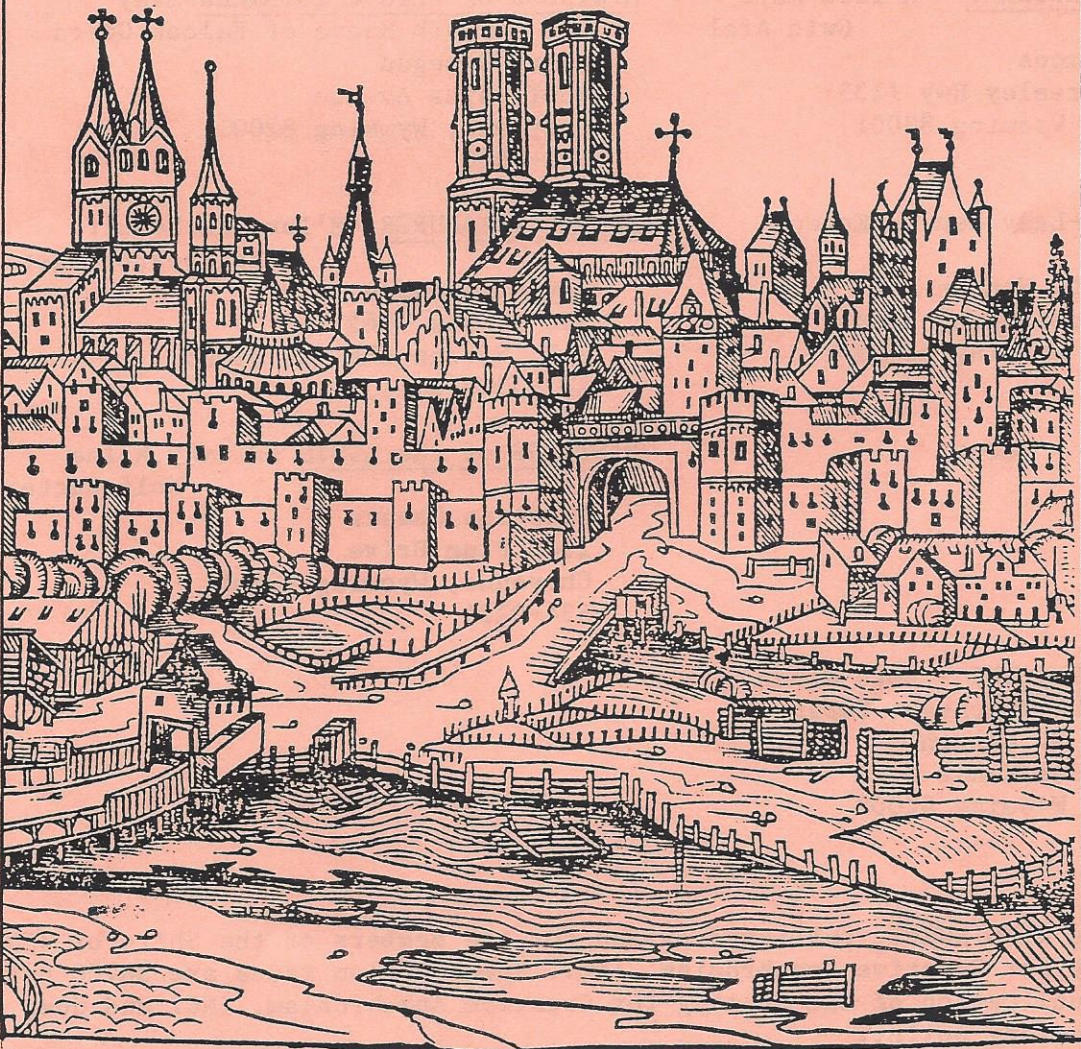


WINDSWEPT

UNSER HAFEN FIGHTER'S PRACTICE

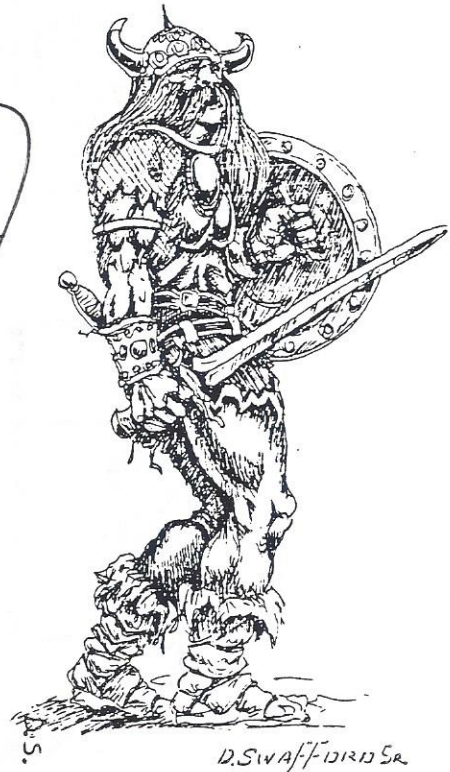

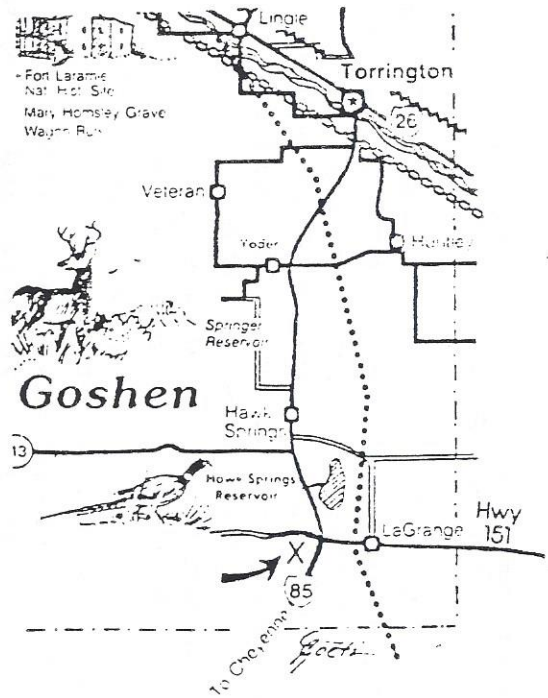

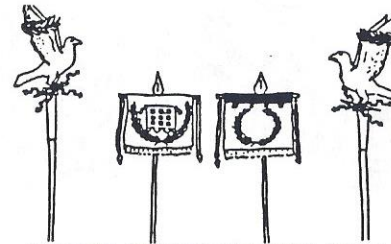

This Banquet will of course feature Roman Cuisine! It will be excellent. The Banquet will be in a site to be named in the next OH, it will not be a Windhover Cliff.

This will be a camping event with fun and games for everyone and at least one Bardic fire. The site's well cannot handle the demand this event will put on it, so WATER MUST BE BROUGHT IN. Brainstorming and organizational meeting will take place on August 6 beginning at 1pm at the address below. If you cannot attend and have some ideas or assistance to offer please write.

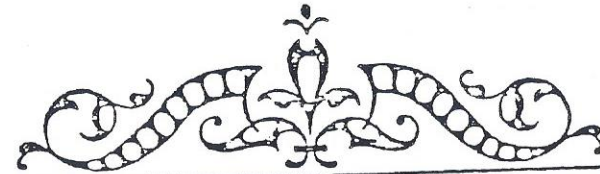

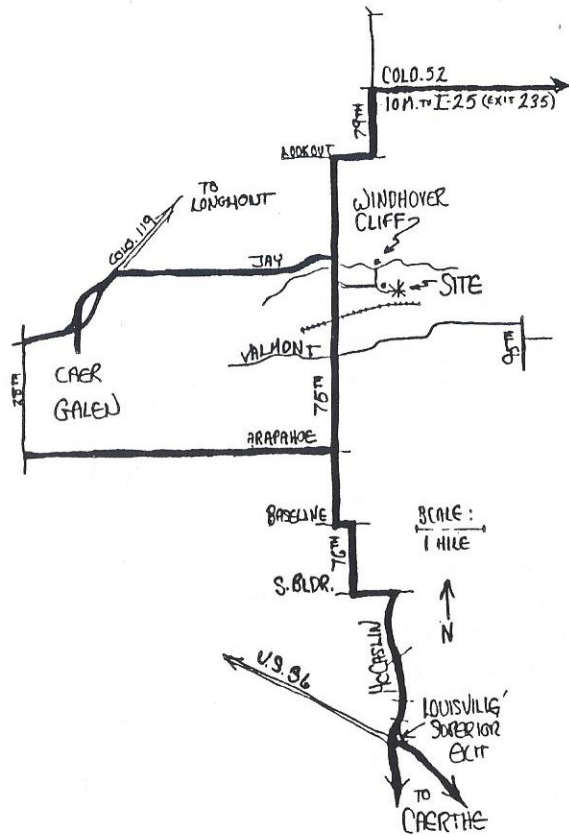

SWEET & SOUR ONION RAISIN RELISH

by M'lady Aldith a Baddon Poeth

- 1 Sweet red bell pepper - chopped
or
- 1 jar Pimientos - diced
- Zest of 2 oranges
- 1 pound Baby white onions
- 2 tbsp. Sugar - or to taste
- 1/2 Cup Red wine vinegar - or to taste
- 2 1/2 tbsp. Olive oil
- 1/3 Cup Golden Raisins
- 1/2 Cup Currants
- 1 tbsp. Tomato paste
- 3/4 Cup dry white wine

Roast and peel red pepper, chop. Remove zest of oranges and cut into 1/16 inch strips. Melt sugar in non-corrodable pan over low heat, stir in vinegar - SLOWLY - add all ingredients except olive oil and wine, and heat thoroughly. Cool before serving, add olive oil and wine, stir thoroughly just prior to serving.

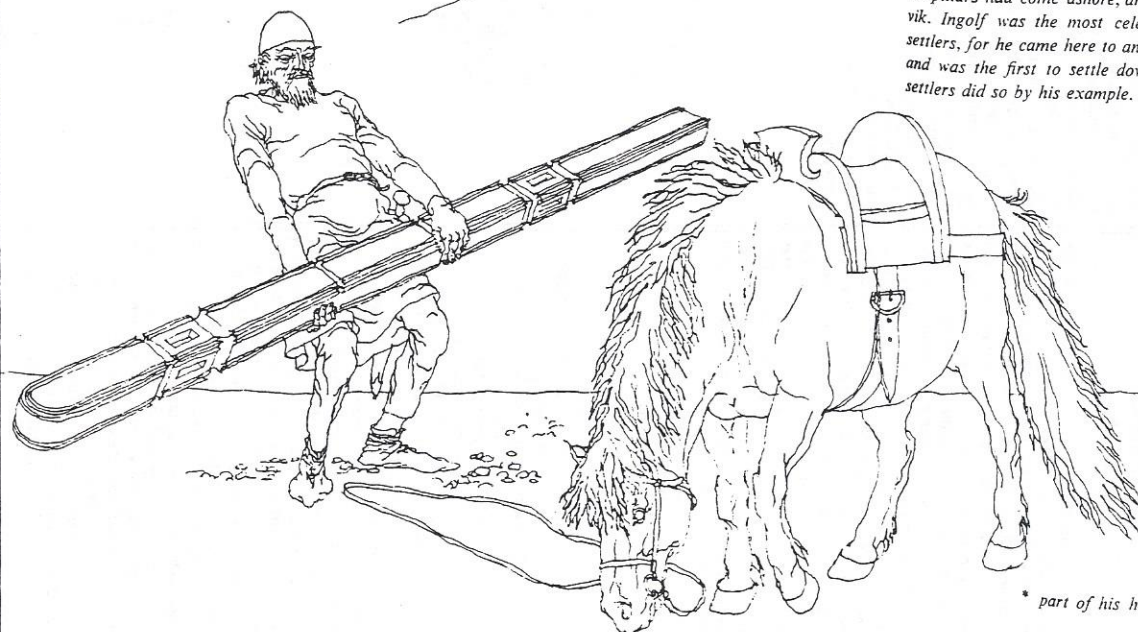

TIME-VALUE: DON'T-DELAY

THE FIRST SETTLER'S PILLARS ARE FOUND

*From the Book of the Settlements
As soon as Ingolf sighted Iceland, he cast his high-seat pillars* overboard for an omen, vowing he would settle where the pillars came ashore. Vifil and Karli found his high-seat pillars by Arnarhval, west of the heath. In the spring Ingolf came down over the heath, to site his home where his pillars had come ashore, and lived at Reykjavik. Ingolf was the most celebrated of all the settlers, for he came here to an unlivid-in country and was the first to settle down in it: the other settlers did so by his example.*
