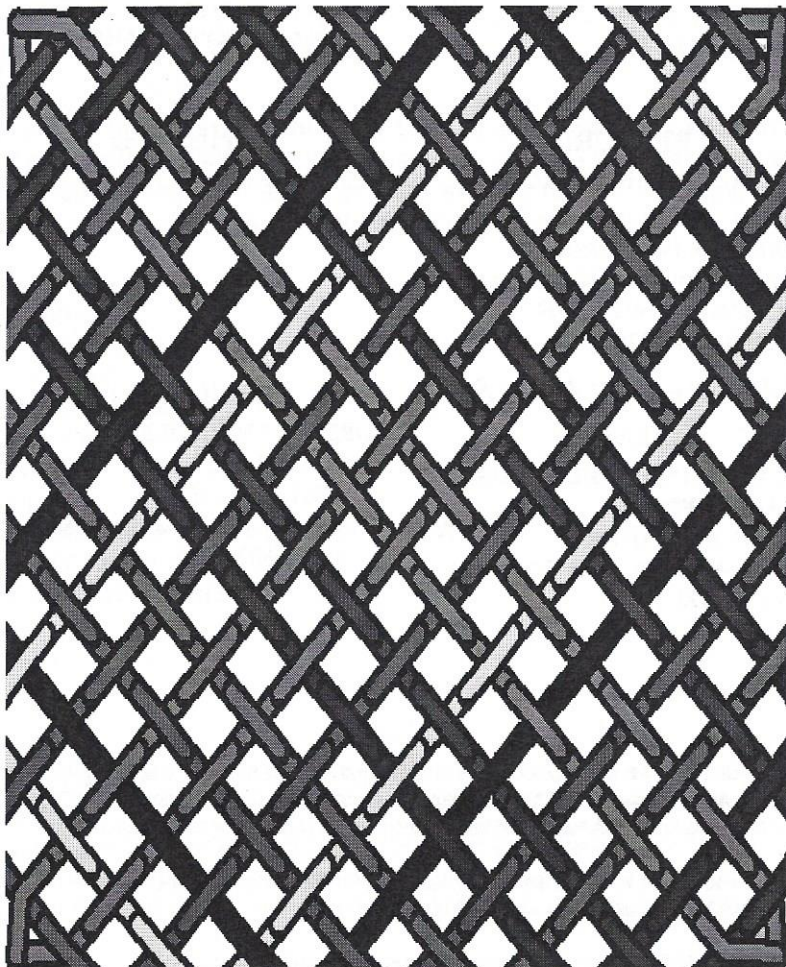

Banner Tourney



The shire of Windkeep would like to invite all to join us for Banner Tourney. This event is held in conjunction with the city of Cheyenne's annual Superdays celebration, so be prepared to wear your finest garb and bring items to display so the community can learn more about the SCA. There will be heavy and light weapons tourneys, with prizes in a number categories including best bereavement and best death. Each fighter wishing to enter will need to bring a banner as an entrance fee. The banner does not need to be of your arms, and it can be merely decorative, but we do ask that the banner is heraldically correct. Lady Gabriella will also be holding an A&S competition to choose the new A&S Champion for the shire.

We have been fortunate enough to have the use of the Gazebo again this year and Mistress Aldyth will be organizing a BBQ. The shire will provide hamburgers and hotdogs and the fixings. To defray the cost of the food we will be charging a nominal fee of \$3.00 per adult, \$1.50 per child 5-12 with children under 5 free.

Because the site is a public park, the site is EXTREMELY dry, and due to the sprinkler system we ask that you use tent stakes 6 inches or shorter for your pavilions.

The site will open at 8:00 am and close at 8:00 pm.

Directions: If you are coming from the east or west, take I-80 to Cheyenne, take exit 359C to I-25 north, then follow the directions below from there.

If you are coming from the north or south take I-25 to Cheyenne to the Central Avenue exit (exit 12), turn south and continue 1.3 miles to 8th avenue, turn right onto 8th avenue continue .4 miles, to the Frontier Park/Lion's Park entrance and turn right. We will be set up on the right side and you can park on the side of the road to unload. After you have unloaded get a parking pass from the autocrat so that you can park for free.

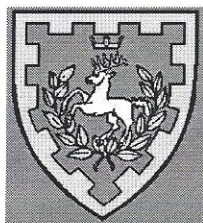

The Shire of Windkeep invites all members of the populace to join them at the Coronation of the successors to Their Royal Majesties Caesan and Vanna. While Their Majesties' reign has been just and true, their strength wanes, and their heirs must ascend to the Throne of the Outlands. To this end, a Coronation celebration has been planned in the Shire of Windkeep on May 12, A.S. XXXVI, being 2001 in the Gregorian era.

This wondrous occasion will be held at two beautiful locations. The days' tournaments will be held at the Lions Park Softball Complex. Flat expanses of lawn and plenty of parking abound. Public restrooms are nearby, and there is a playground area to help keep small children occupied. The general schedule is as follows:

9:30a-10:00a	Morning Melees will be organized and fought throughout the morning
by 12:00 Noon	Coronation Ceremony
Following ceremony	Queen's Champion/Protector of Queen's Heart tourneys until approx 5:00p
5:00p-6:00p	Showers will be available
7:00p	Feast begins
11:00p	Feast Hall closes for clean-up

In the event of inclement weather, the fighting will be moved indoors to the Wyoming National Guard Armory. As you can see, there will be ample amounts of fighting for all, so **PLEASE** do bring your armor! Also, please bear in mind that being a public park, the tournament site is **BONE DRY**. Should the local constabulary patrol through and find alcohol on site, we will all be asked to vacate the premises, so please leave all libations for the evening feast. In addition to the tournaments, Lady Christina McCarty, Outlands Kingdom Chronicler, will be sponsoring a box lunch auction to help benefit the *Outlandish Herald*. For more information on this, please contact Lady Christina. Her information can be found on the inside front cover of the O.H. Should time permit, the newly installed Crown may wish to have a Kingdom Officer's meeting. In addition, they have planned to have peer circles at Unser Hafen fighter Practice on Sunday, May 13 between 10:00a and 2:00p. Circle scheduling will be done at the Unser Hafen practice site.

The evening feast will be held at St. Mark's Episcopal Church. This magnificent granite and sandstone building will provide a wonderful backdrop for the evening feast. The feast site is **DISCREETLY WET**, allowing for beer and wine only in period containers. There is no smoking allowed in the church, or on the church property. As the church is adjacent to another large building, there will be ample space to smoke off the premises. Also, no pets will be allowed on the premises with the exception of working animals assisting the disabled.

Mistress Aldyth Trefaldwyn and The Inn of the Guilded Griffin will be providing the evening feast, with Lady Galiana William heading up the kitchen. **PAID** reservations are a must if you wish to guarantee seating. Seating is limited to the first 125 paid reservations, therefore a paid reservation will gain precedence over non-paid reservations, regardless of when the reservation arrived. Reservations should be received by May 5, so that the cooks will have time to purchase the items they need. There will be **NO** off-board seating. Food related questions, concerns and allergy notifications can be sent to Mistress Aldyth. All reservations must go to the Autocrat, or you run the risk of not having your reservation counted.

If you wish to volunteer to assist in site setup for one or both sites, please contact The Honorable Lady Noemi at the information below. If you wish to volunteer to assist in site cleanup for one or both sites, please contact Lady Africa O'Brien at the information below. If you have any other questions or concerns, please contact the autocrat.

Directions: To the Tourney Site or feast site From I-80: Take I-80 to the Casper Exit (Exit 359C) North. Follow directions from I-25. **To the Tourney Site From I-25:** Follow I-25 to the Central Ave Exit (Exit 12). Turn south on Central into the right lane and go approximately 1.3 miles to 8th Avenue. Bear right onto 8th Avenue and go approximately 0.4 miles to the Frontier Park/Lions Park entrance. Turn right into the park. Take the first right onto S. Lions Park Drive. Follow the road around until you reach the softball field complex. Parking will be on the left. **To the feast site from the tourney site:** Exit Lions' park the same way you came in and turn left onto 8th Avenue and get into the right lane. Continue approximately 0.4 miles to Central Avenue and turn right. Drive approximately 1.2 miles into downtown Cheyenne. The church is on the right hand corner of 19th and Central. Parking is available as per the map. Please keep in mind the number of one-way streets in Cheyenne. All one-ways are marked on the map. **To get directly to the feast site from I-25:** Take I-25 to the Central Avenue Exit (Exit 12). Turn south on Central and drive approximately 2.5 miles into downtown Cheyenne. . The church is on the right hand corner of 19th and Central. Parking is available as per the map. Please keep in mind the number of one-way streets in Cheyenne. All one-ways are marked on the map.

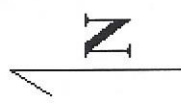
