Tournament of the Singing Aspen

The Baronry of Caerthe and the Shire of Caer Galen invite you to spend a Japanese weekend at the Tournament of the Singing Aspen (from August 1-3). The tourney will be held in the mountains northwest of Caerthe at the Oshino-east (Pickles Ditch) Campground in the Arapahoe National Forest near the towns of Blackhawk and Central City, Colorado.

The site is a newly renovated, beautiful campground nestled in the Rocky Mountains and covered with aspen trees. There is a great deal of shade, yet the area is well enough manicured to allow for wood battles. The designated camping area is set up for groups—there are five campsites set up with firepits, tent pads, (your tent will be on level ground and won't flood!). Toilet facilities are available, but there are no showers. There is some water available for washing, but none for drinking, therefore, **BRING WATER!**

The site will open at noon on Friday, August 1st, for set up. The site-fee for the entire weekend—Friday through Sunday—is as follows:

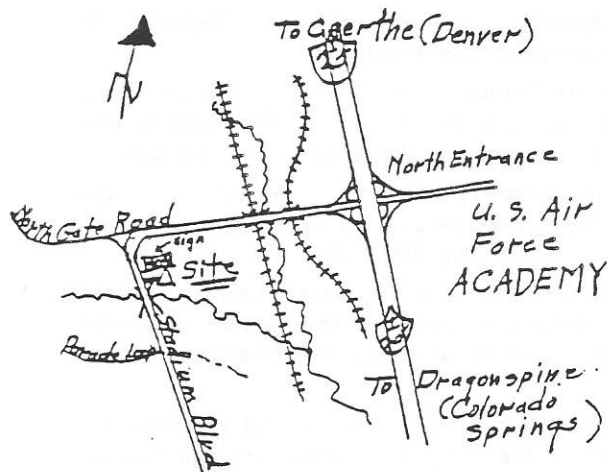
The tourney will be fought weapons of choice, but all entrants must be presented before Her Excellency and be acceptable to her.

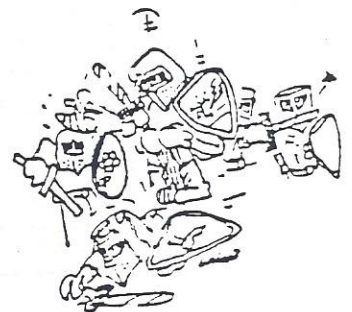
