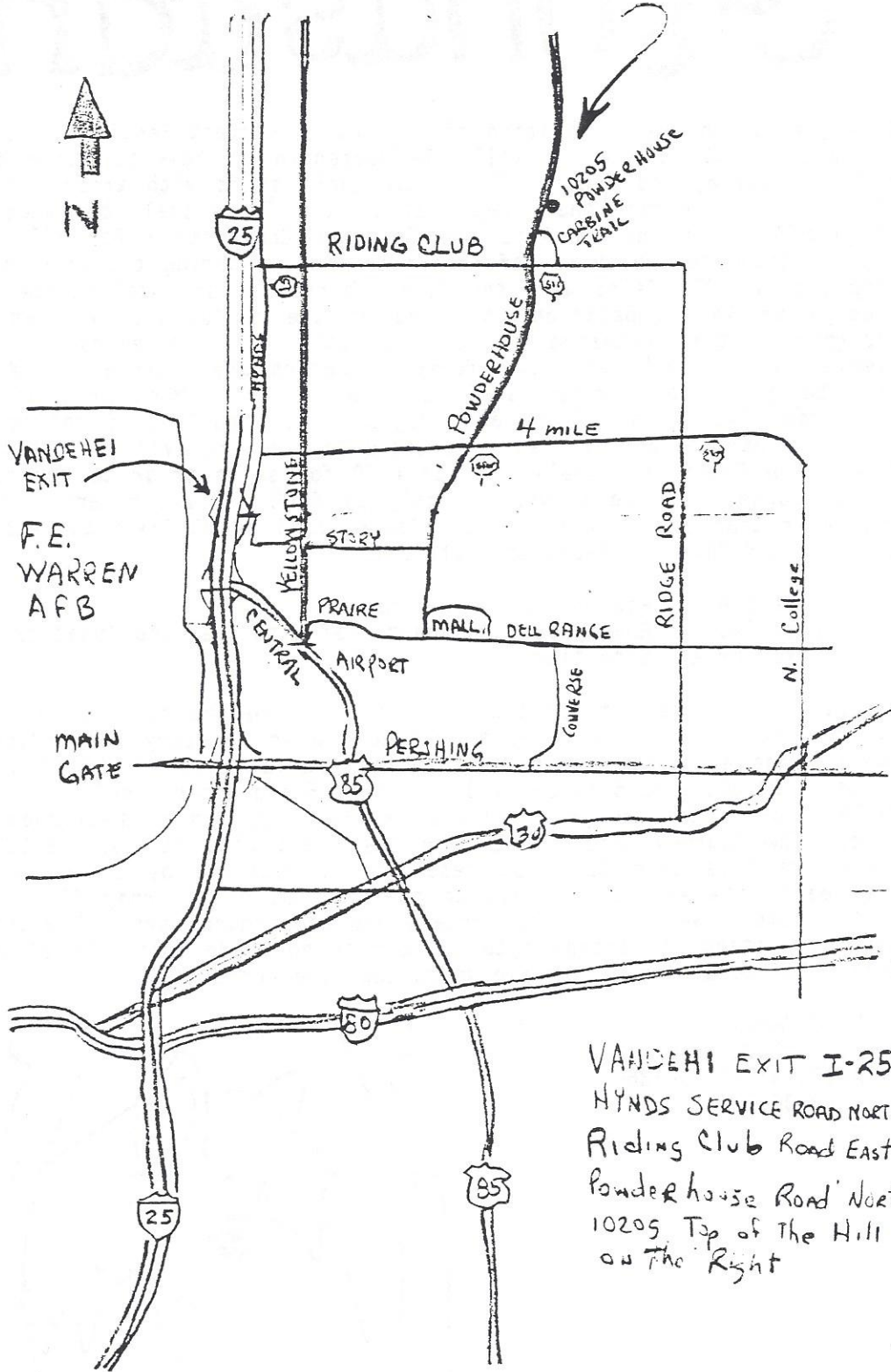

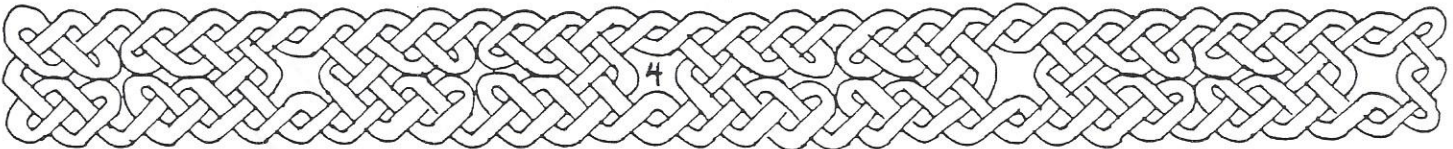

The event shall start with armor inspection at 11:00 and the Tourney shall begin at 12:00. There shall be games available for non-fighters and an Arts and Sciences Competition for all. There is a \$1.00 Site Fee, which is refundable to those entering the Arts and Sciences Competition. The Celts were the first to develop and utilize the horseshoe. Thusly our A&S Competition is based on the horseshoe. All entries must incorporate the horseshoe in the formation of the entry. Fancy work, needlecraft, as well as other forms of design are acceptable. All entries will be judged and prizes shall be awarded for: Most Original Use of a Horseshoe, Best Celtic Theme and Judges Whim. Challenge Fighting on Sunday 12-?, if there is any interest. Limited showers are available at the tourney site. The Feast Hall shall open at 5:00 for setup prior to the feast. The first course shall be served promptly at 6:00. Feast reservations are due not later than 1 July A.S. XXIII. There shall be **NO** feast tickets available after that date. The Feast consists of:

Bread, butter, fresh fruit and nuts shall be on the table(s) at the start of the feast. Those wishing to attend, having dietary restrictions please contact the autocrats, when sending in reservations. FEAST FEES: Ages 13 to Adult \$8.00, ages 6 to 12 \$4.00 and ages 5 and under Free.

RESTRICTIONS: Smoking in designated areas only. No pets allowed at either site. The Tourney Site is **WET** and the Feast Site is **dry**. EXCEPTION: If there are less than 21 feast reservations received by 1 July A.S. XXIII, the Feast Site will be changed to the same as the Tourney Site, and thusly will become a wet site. WARLORD and PREMIER CAERTHE, AUG. 6-7 BLADE

This year's Warlord/Premier Blade Tourney will be held in the mountains of Caerthe, with camping in Arapahoe National Forest next to Dillon Reservoir, and only a 1-hour drive from the home of the Baroness. DIRECTIONS: From Caerthe, take I-70 West to the Dillon Exit. Turn left on US 6 through Dillon (approximately 7 miles) to Swan Mountain Road. Turn right on Swan Mountain Road to the Windy Point turnoff (2 miles). There will be signs.

Master Giovanni, Warlord, and Lord Ian, Premier Blade, have planned many diverse and interesting lists to determine next year's Warlord and Premier Blade. All fighters are welcome and there will be a prize for the winners of the Tourneys. There will be many other activities and contests going on through out the weekend. 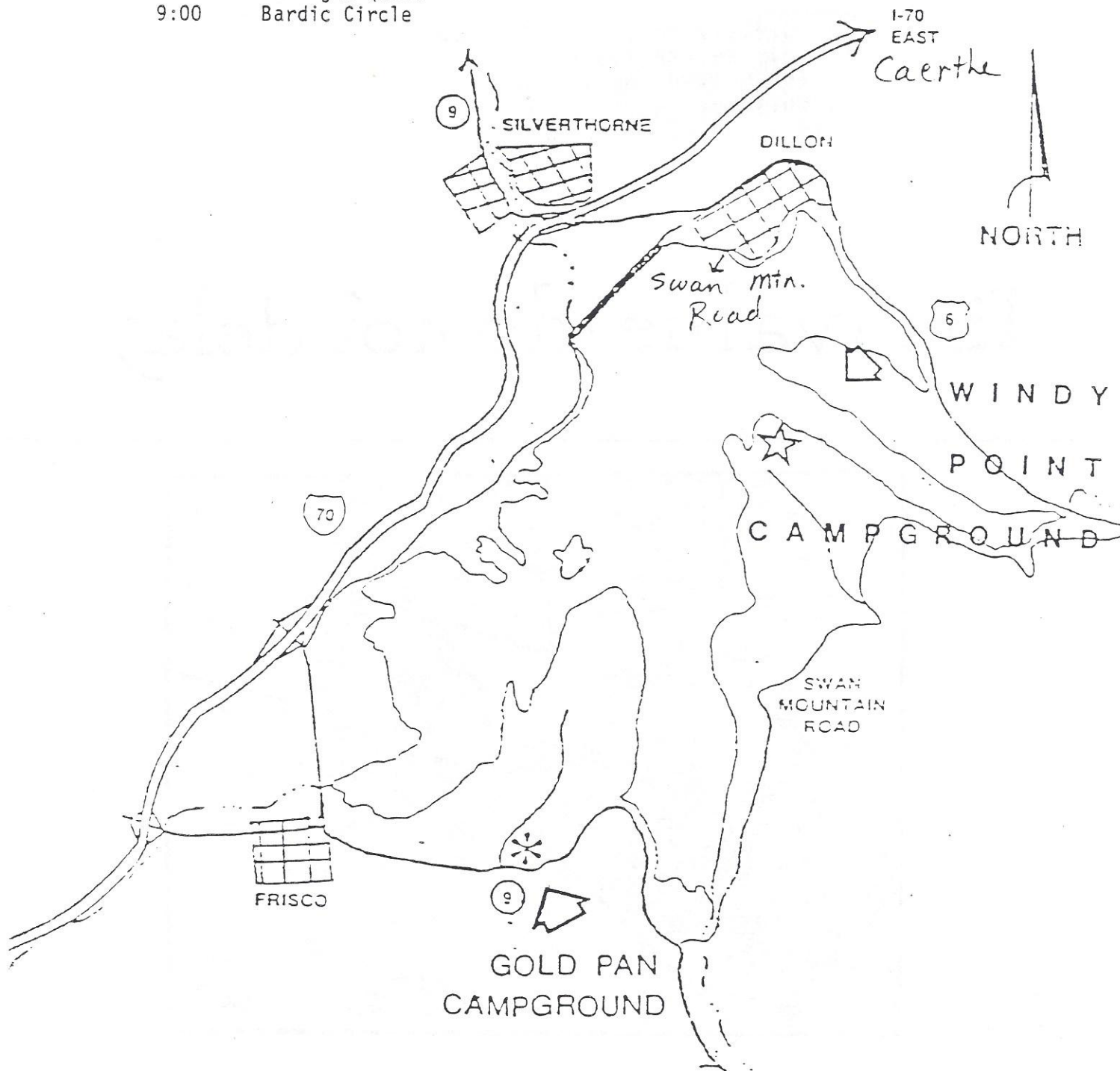

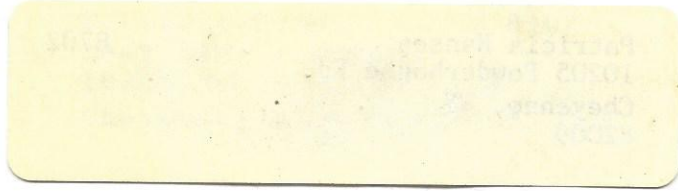
