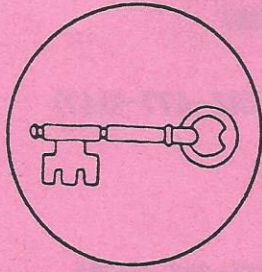

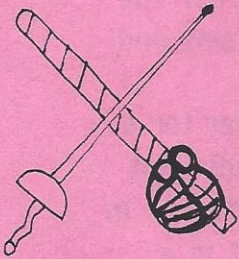

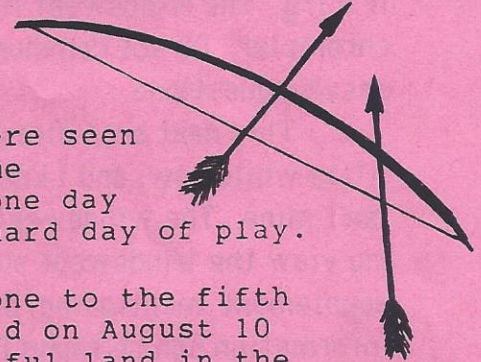
## Three Hawks Champion Tournament

A fighter, a fencer, and an archer were seen working together on a brilliant scheme to go to the Three Hawks Tournament one day and to become the champions after a hard day of play.



The Canton of Hawks Hollow welcomes everyone to the fifth annual Three Hawks Champion Tournament to be held on August 10 and 11, 1991. The site is located on the beautiful land in the Black Forest near Monument, CO—about 53 miles south of Denver (please refer to map). The site will open at 2:00 Friday afternoon and will close Sunday evening at 6:00. The site fee is \$2.00 per person for the whole weekend and remember this is a camping event, so plan to stay. There are plenty of trees for shade, (two) firepits to share (depending how dry it is), firewood, the site is very wet, there is no water (bring your own), and animals are allowed on leashes.

On Saturday we will have four individual competitions which will include: archery, fencing, heavy weapons, and bardic. We will also be having the team competition to determine the Three Hawks Champions. We will draw teams of three and each person will compete in their individual event with their scores to be added to their teammates scores for a team total. In the evening one person from each team will perform at the bardic. Their score will make up the fourth component of the team total. The team with the best score will become the Three Hawks Champions. You need not be a member of a team to compete for the prizes to be given in each individual competition.

There will be a scavenger hunt for bigs and littles that will begin on Saturday and end on Sunday. There will also be childrens games on Saturday.

We will be having the feast Saturday evening, which will include: breads, cheese, salad, soup, roast beast, and desert. The feast is \$4.00 per person and \$1.00 for littles under 12. 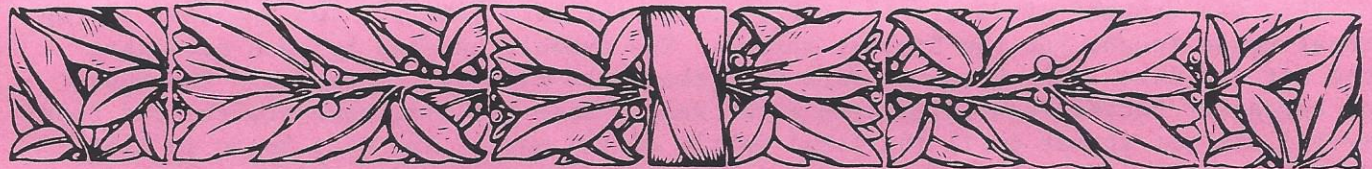
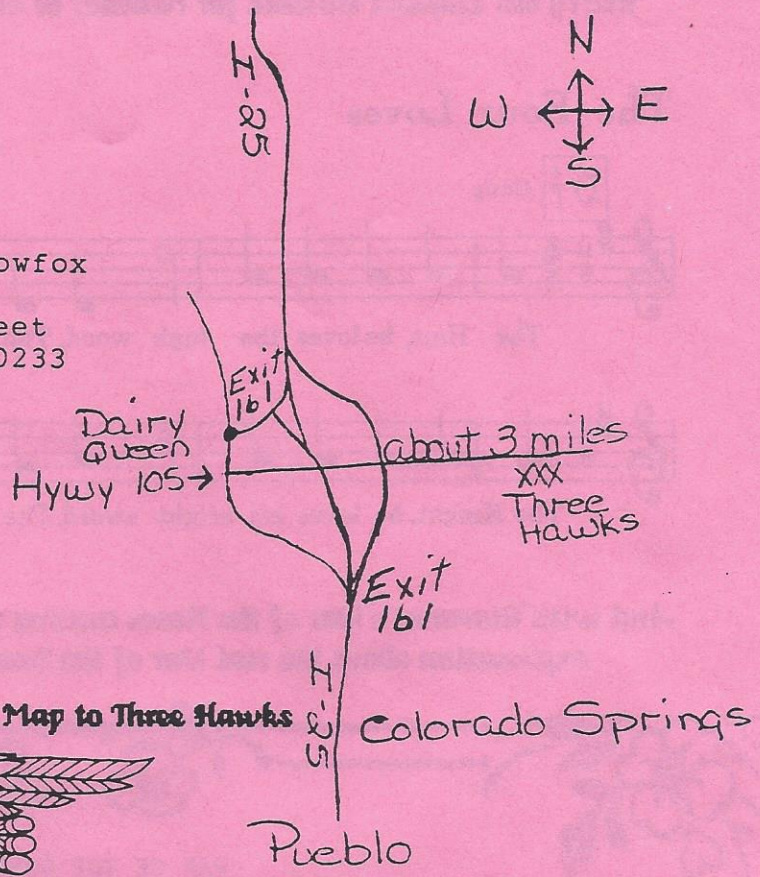
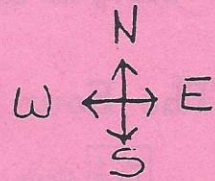

The Herbalist by Joseph E Meyer

This book has information on medicinal plants, dying, spices, teas, poypourri, cosmetics, and much, much more. It is easy to read and very straight forward. First published in 1918, it even covers brewing. Every plant featured has a picture of it followed by its common name(s), medicinal part(s), description, properties, and uses. Many are also follows by the correct dosages for the plant.

The book also covers the different parts of the plants to use and how to use them; how to gather, ship, dry, and store the plants as well.

I have just hit the tip of the iceberg with this book. If you are interested in brewing, dying, herbals, spices, etc. this book is a must for your collection. The 11th printing was in 1976. The Herbalist is published by Meyerbooks, PO Box 427, 235 W Main St, Glenwood, Illinois 60425.



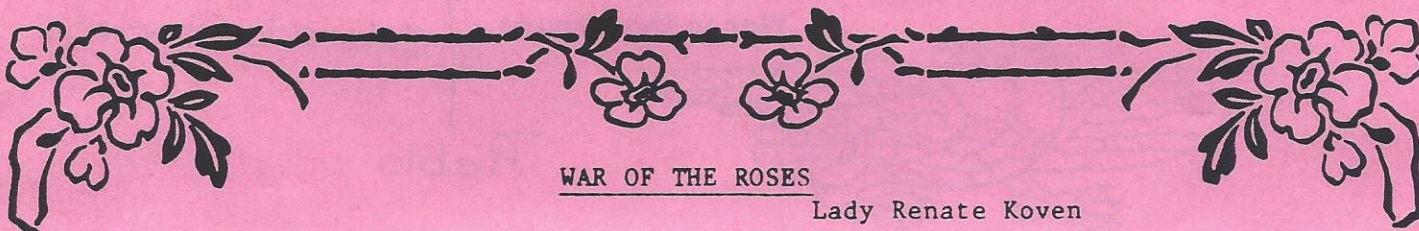

## The Four Loves

And with Giovanni's War of the Roses coming up in August, I thought a little explanation about the real War of the Roses would be appropriate.



This war brought civil strife to England in the late 1400's. Two branches of the royal house fought for the English throne. The symbols adopted by each side gave the war its name. The House of York used the white rose as its emblem. The House of Lancaster became identified with a red rose. Some believe, however, the red rose symbol did not appear until the final battle of the wars. The wars began in 1455 with the Battle of Saint Albans and dragged on spasmodically for thirty years.

King Henry VI of Lancaster held the throne when the war began. Henry's grandfather, Henry IV had seized power in 1399. Richard of York claimed the throne, but was killed in battle in 1460. His cause was continued by his son Edward, who was proclaimed King in London after winning the second battle of Saint Albans in 1461. Henry fled to Scotland. In 1464, Henry was captured and kept in the Tower of London until the Earl of Warwick, now known as the king-maker briefly expelled Edward who took refuge with Charles the Bold of Burgundy. In 1471, Edward again seized the throne, murdered Henry's son and sent Henry back to the Tower of London, where he too, was murdered.

The House of York ruled until Richard III lost his throne to the Lancaster descendant, Henry Tudor, who became King Henry VII in 1485. Henry VII married Elizabeth, daughter of Edward IV, uniting the Houses of Lancaster and York, and founding the Tudor dynasty.

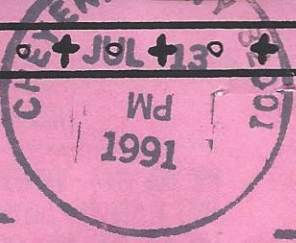

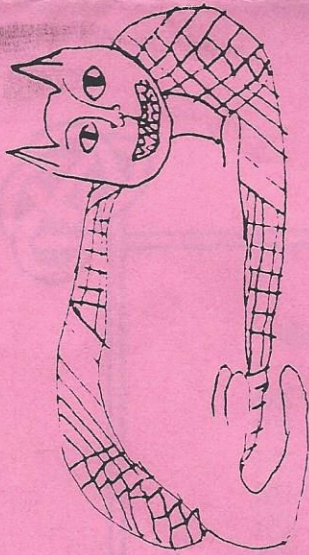
