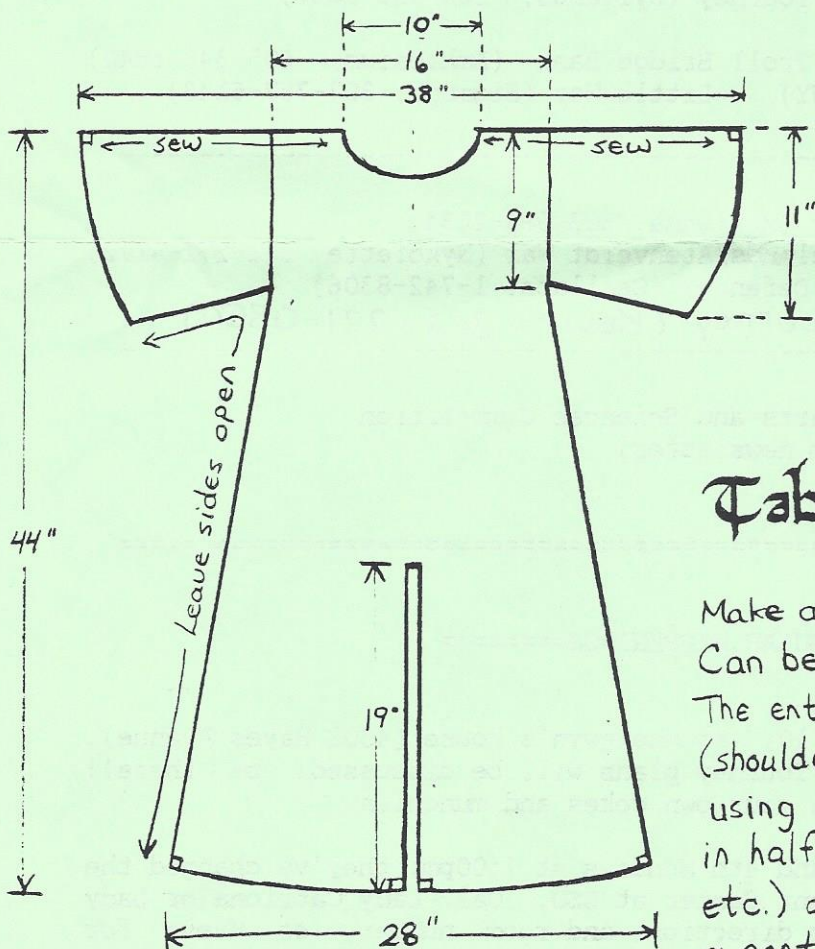

Tabard Pattern

Make a tabard for your favorite fighter!
 Can be made with "sleeves" or sleeveless.
 The entire tabard can be made in one piece (shoulder seam line would be placed on fold) using 2 1/2 yds of 44" wide fabric, folded in half. Hem or bind (with bias tape, ribbon, etc.) all edges, or line entire tabard with a contrasting color. Appliqué or paint the wearers device, badge, or favorite design motif on it.
 One size fits all!

THE TOURNEY STARTS AT NOON; ARMOR INSPECTION WILL BE AT 11:00 AM.

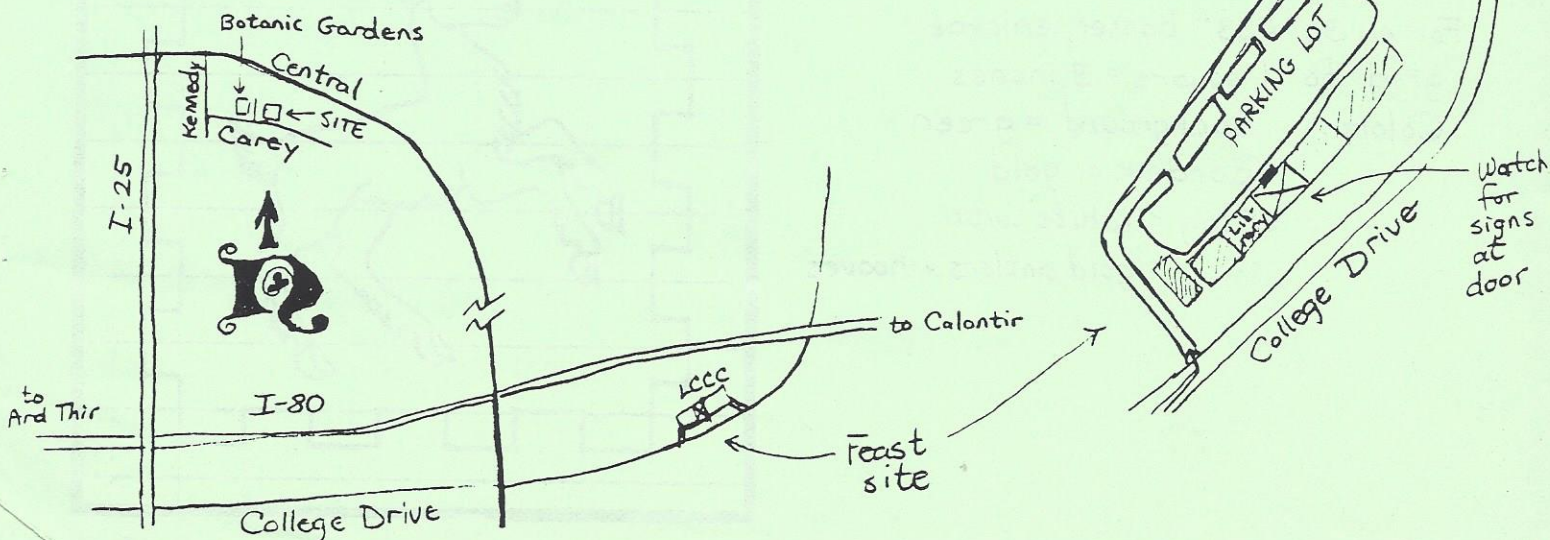

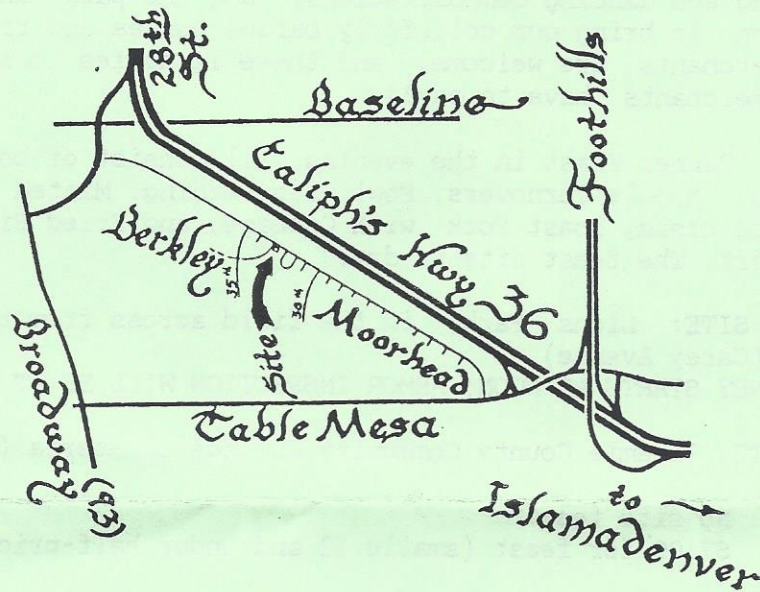

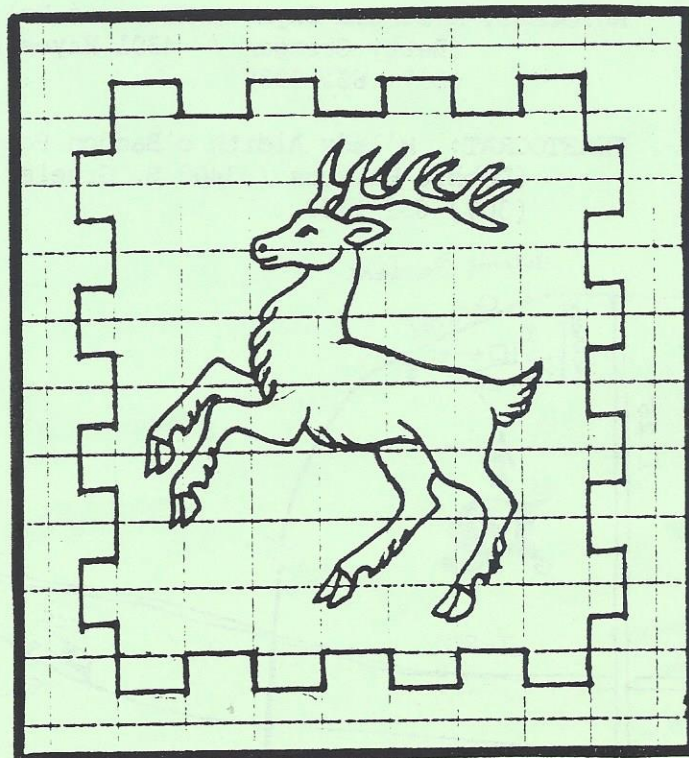

WHERE: Little Mountain, south of Rock Springs, Wyoming (see map)

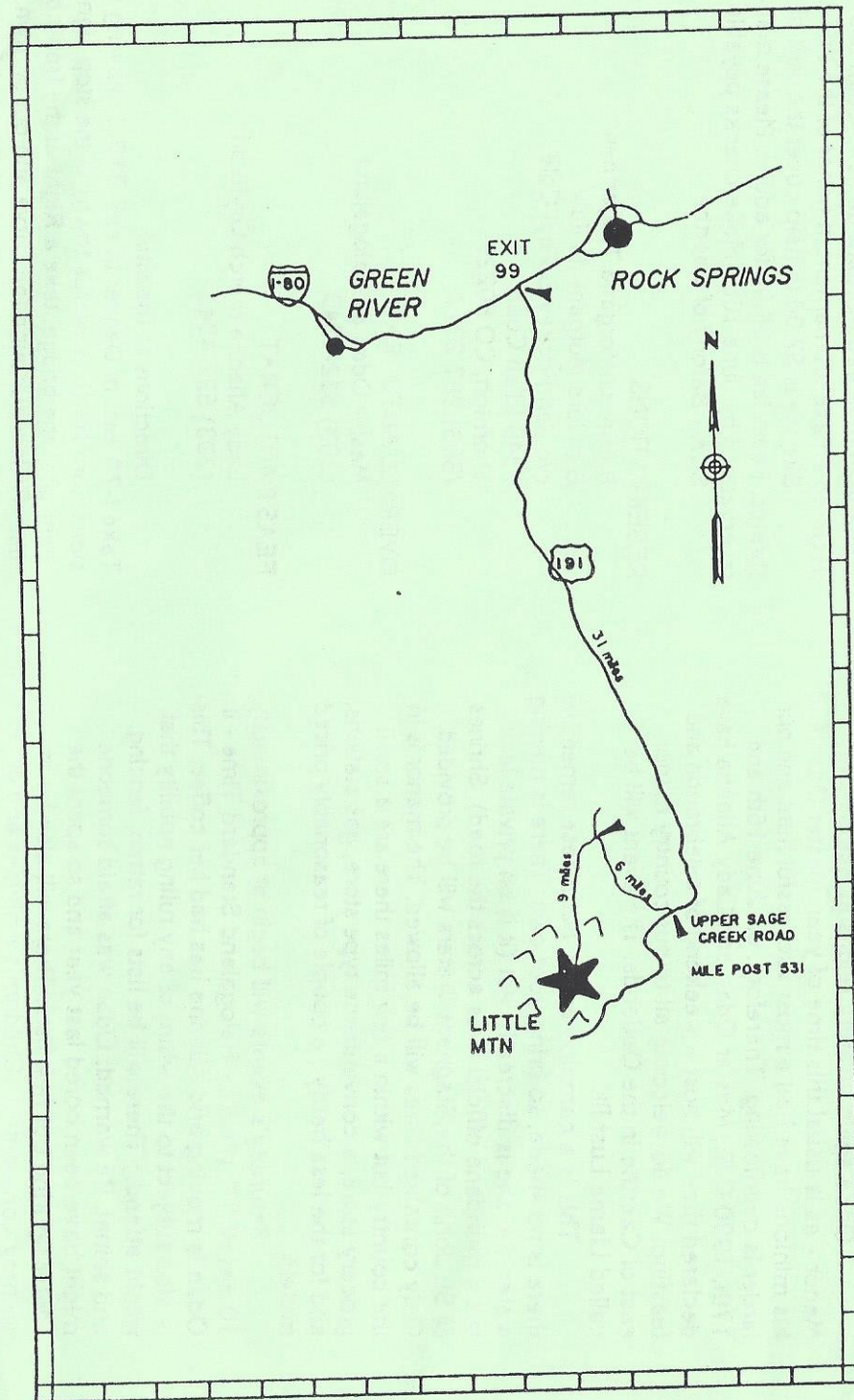
SITE FEE: \$1.00, fighting fee \$1.00

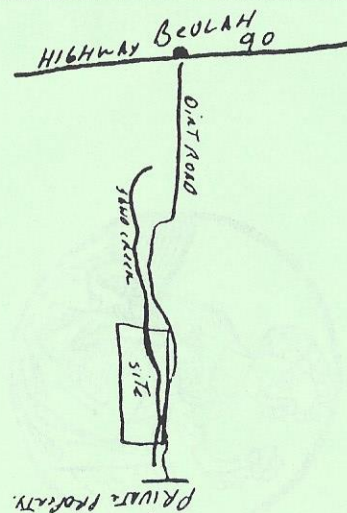
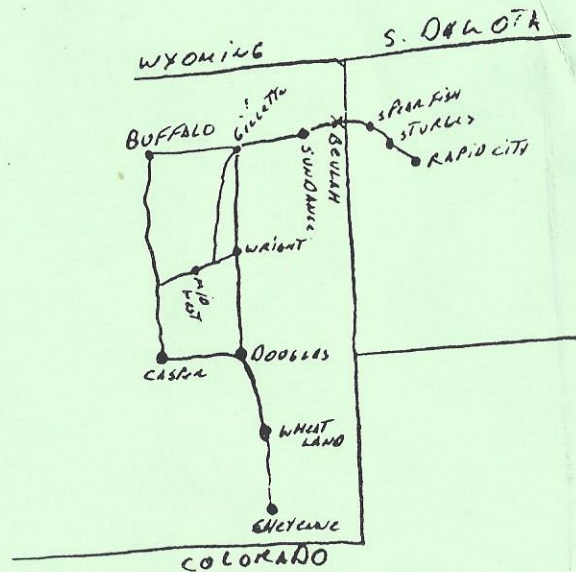
There will be a tournament in both archery and fighting, along with such things as the first official carp shoot and a cold water, inner tube race (clothing optional). There will be awards for all contests.

If coming from Rapid City proceed West on Highway 90 to Beulah WY. turn off and follow the same directions. The ultimate destination is the Creek known as Sand.



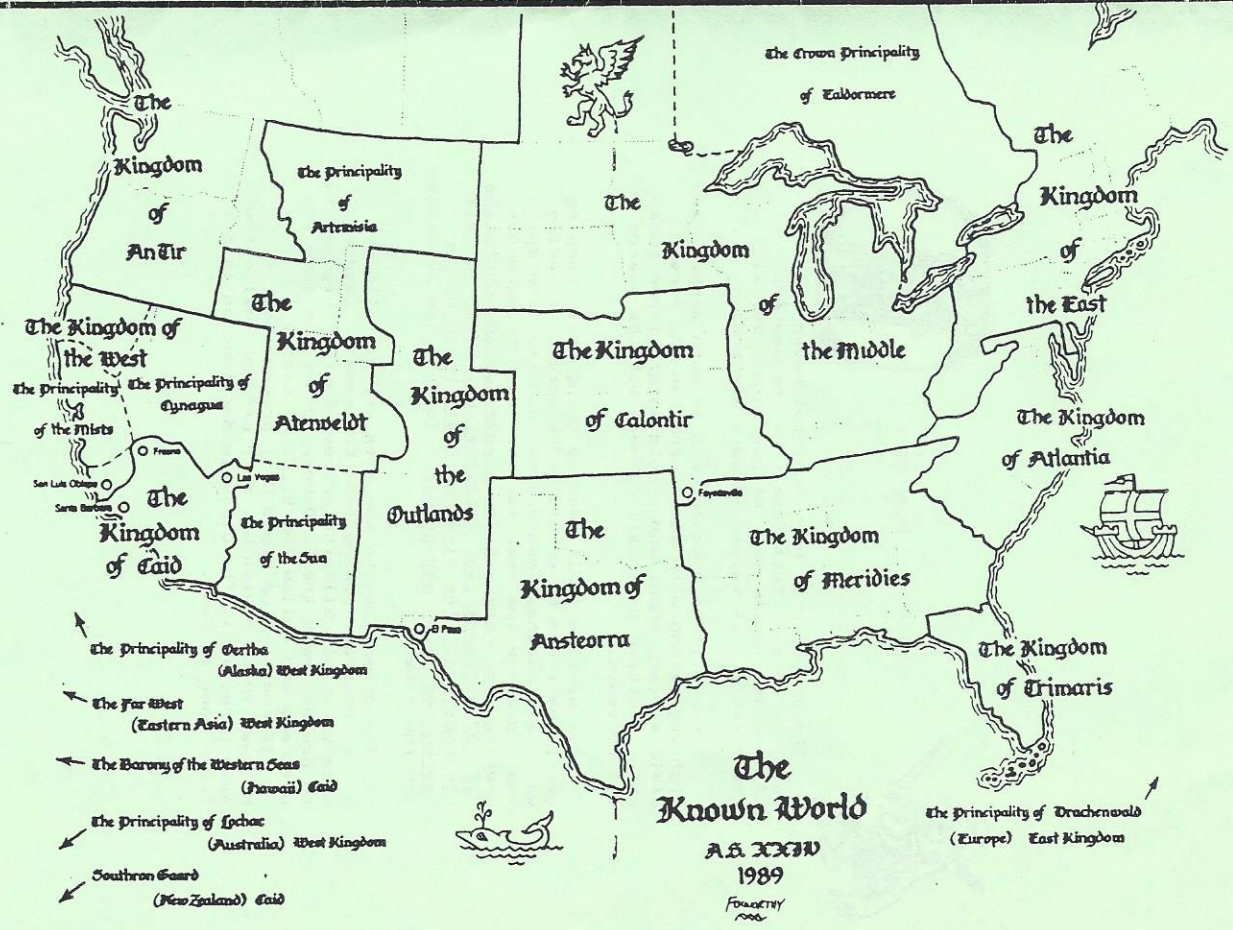
