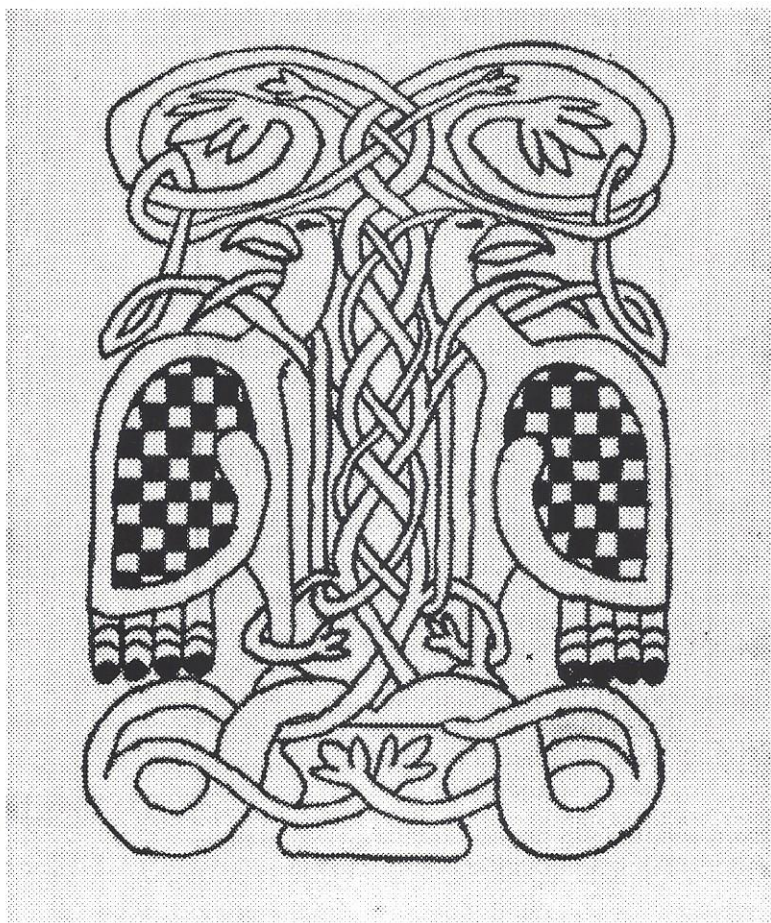

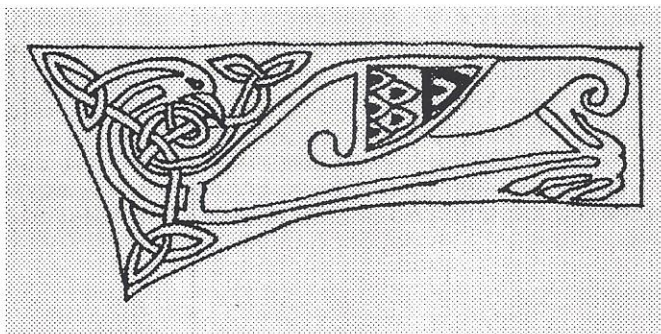

The merriment will begin Friday, June 5<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 p.m. and continue through Sunday, June 7<sup>th</sup>, when the site closes at 12 noon. The site is private property near Keyhole State Park in Wyoming. This will be a camping event, anyone who would like to attend but does not wish to camp should be prepared to travel 10 or 15 miles to locate an inn. The site is **primitive with no water available**, so please plan on **bringing your own drinking water!** Privies will be provided, along with hand washing facilities, unfortunately no showers will be available. Due to the nature of the site, please do not bring any **beasts** with you, as we do not want to feed the local fauna nor see someone lose a beloved pet. Anyone planning on building their own camp fire while camping please bring a fire extinguisher.

An Archery Tournament and a Fighter Tourney will highlight the day on Saturday, June 6<sup>th</sup>. 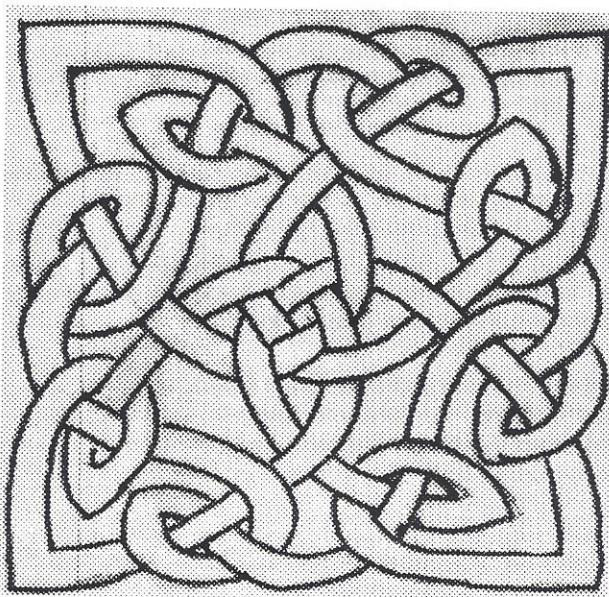

## Cattle Raid III

*Bofharrach, June 19-21, AS XXXIII (1998)*

Once again in the green pastures of Bofharrach there will be a weekend of frolic and fun as we celebrate that most loved animal of our canton, the cow! We will be playing in the same location as past years, the privately owned land east of Kersey. There will be fighting, fencing, archery, equestrians tourneys, and Hawks Hollow will be joining us for a Sunday filled with melees. We will also be choosing a champion of Bofharrach, to be selected by a test of strength, wits, speed, and athletic ability on the field of our version of the highland games. Some children's activities will be available.

Site will open at 12:00 p.m. on Friday, June 19th and closes at 5:00 p.m. Sunday, June 21.

**Site restrictions:** no dogs, no open flames (there will be a well-supervised Bardic fire after the evening tourney Saturday night), and no alcohol. This is a dry site. There is no water on site so please plan to bring your own. Also remember that this site is located on river bottom land so the bugs can be bad. Please remember your insect repellent as well as sunscreen and shade.

**Directions:** The site is located 2 miles east of Kersey, CO. To get to the site, take your best route to I-25 and exit 257-A (Greeley exit) do not take the 257-B or you will end up in Loveland. Take US Highway 34 East past Greeley. Stay on Highway 34 until you come to the small town of Kersey (approximately 40 miles from I-25) Just past the High School look for Weld county road 56 and turn left (north). Follow this road to the end, turn left, and follow the signs. The official address of the site is the Kielian property, 28011 US Highway 34, Kersey, CO. (In case flooding we will again have Mr. Doughman's pasture for the alternate site.)

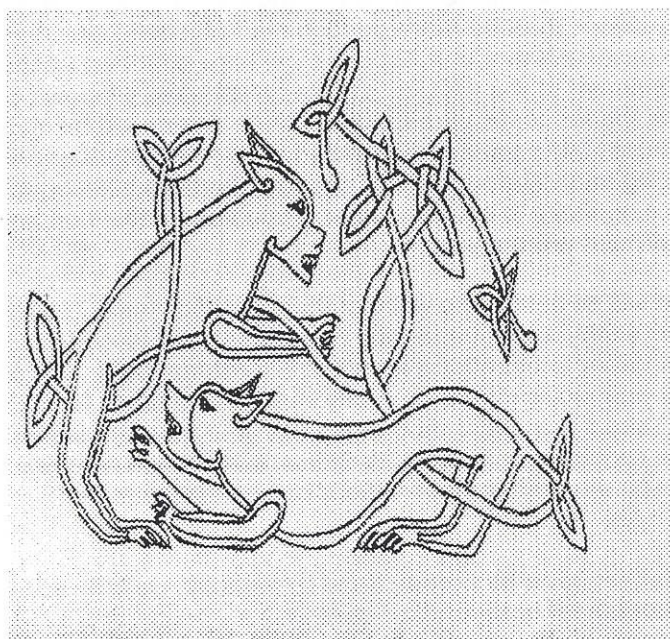
**Fees:** Site fee is \$5 for adults and \$2 for children under 12, if you come for just the day the site fee is \$2. There will be no feast this year, However there will be a meal available Saturday afternoon. Also there will be a list of markets, restaurants, and hotels available at the troll booth. The Equestrian Tourney fee will be \$8.00 per rider; you must be an authorized rider and a paid member of the SCA to ride. If you are bringing a horse, reservations must be made through the Autocrat in advance. Free pasture is available but you must bring your own method of confinement. If you wish to ride, but do not have your own horse, please contact the Autocrat to see if there will be horses available. The Equestrian Tourney will be held Saturday morning under the supervision of Lady Thorhalla, starting at 9:00 a.m. sharp to avoid the heat, if you are not there on time we will start without you.

Court will be held at the whim of their Excellencies of Unser Hafen and/or any other visiting Royalty. We will also be holding a fundraiser to benefit the Kingdom Equestrian Guild. You can have your picture taken on a fully caparisoned horse for a small fee! Take it home and show it off to all your friends and family. Make checks payable to: SCA-Bofharrach. All children must be accompanied by an adult, we will not be responsible for unsupervised children.

## Banner Tourney

Good gentles of the Outlands, Harken. The Shire of Windkeep invites all to attend our annual Banner Tourney to be held on Saturday, June 27, 1998 from 10:00a till 3:00p Valiant fighters will contest on the field with an Outlands Banner as the prize for the most flamboyant and chivalrous fighter in the lists (there will probably be a prize for the winner, too, but **SHOWMANSHIP** is what counts.) There will also be prizes for best death, best bereavement, as well as a contest for the best banner. Fencers are welcome. In order to enter the list, you must present a banner to the Mistress of the Lists and display it on the field. The banner doesn't have to be your own. The banner can display personal arms, historical arms, or be just plain decorative. **HERALDRY COUNTS.** Fanfares and demonstrations before combat are encouraged.

This tournament is held in conjunction with Cheyenne **SUPERDAYS 98**, which is an entertainment, demonstration and craft fair held by the City of Cheyenne. It routinely draws 20,000 visitors each year. We ask all gentles to wear their finest tourney garb, bring their pavilions, music, and arts displays, and show off the best of what our Society has to offer. There will be dancing for all interested, and an Arts and Sciences pavilion where artisans are encouraged to display and demonstrate their abilities.

**Tourney Site:** The grassy area adjacent to the Cheyenne Botanical Gardens in Lions Park. Take Central Avenue exit (Exit 12) from I-25 and follow the signs to **SUPERDAYS**. The site will open at 8:00a and close generally after 3:00p. Please arrive early enough so that armour inspection can begin at 10:00a with the tourney beginning at 10:30a.

**General Information:** The Tourney site is dry! Pets must be kept on a leash, and under your immediate control. There is a

lake very near, so please keep track of your children as well. Merchants are welcome with the following restriction: You must contact the Autocrat for space, and you can only sell to SCA people. If you wish to sell to non-SCA people, a city merchants license is required.

You will be allowed to park along side the site on Carey Avenue to unload, but you must move your vehicle immediately after unloading. Parking will be available in the lots adjacent to **SUPERDAYS**. (Tell the parking attendant you are part of the entertainment.) The earlier you come, the better (closer) the parking. crash space is available, and Master Rhys has also offered his lands to camp out on Friday and Saturday evenings. Please contact the Autocrat directly if you are interested.

**Feast:** Immediately after the day's activities, a revel and feast will be held at the Gazebo in Lyons park. The cooks of Windkeep will be providing culinary delights to satisfy both stomach and soul. The feast site is discreetly wet with beer and wine allowed in period containers. Please contact the Autocrat for additional feast information or concerns.

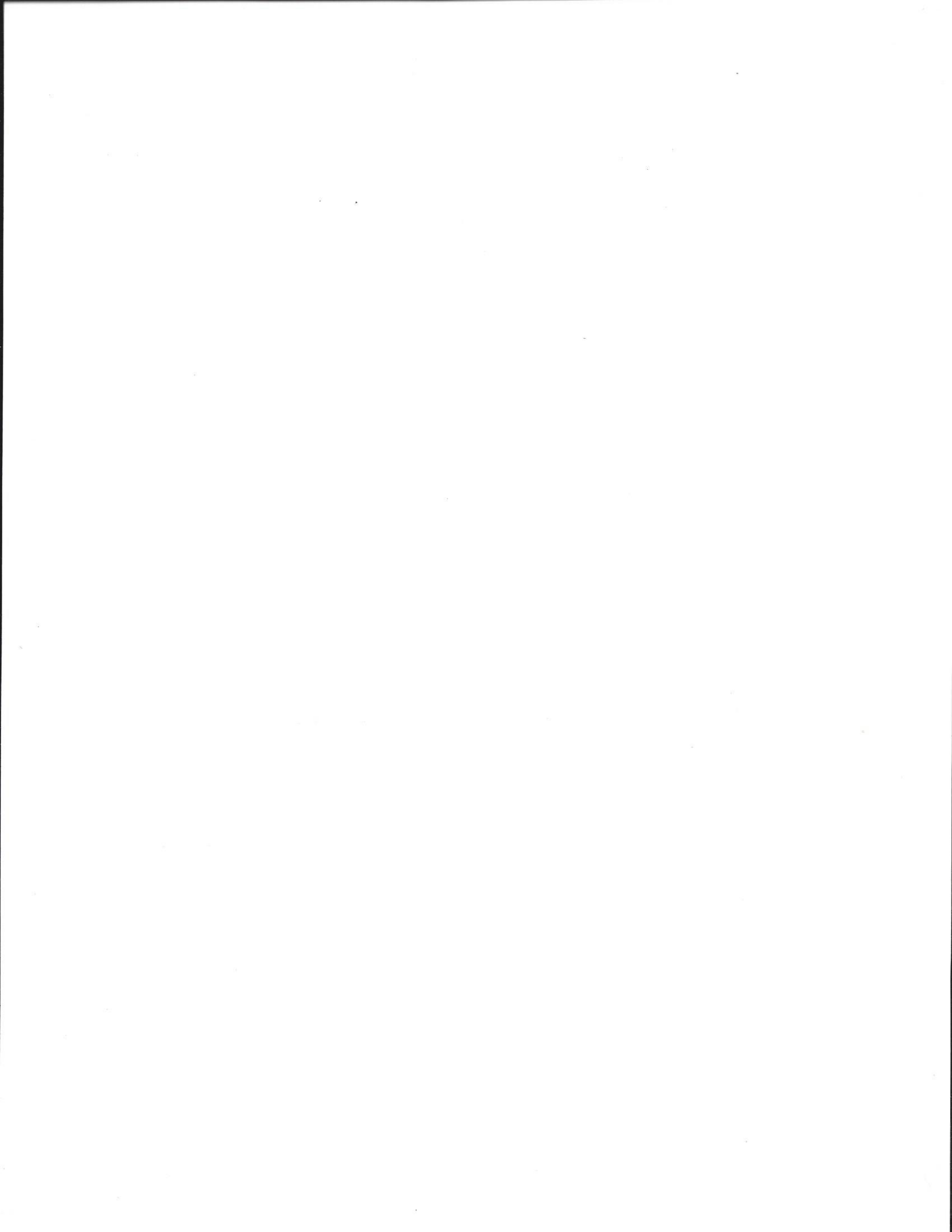
