DATE CHANGE TABLE GUILD FEAST

Due to the number of events in the immediate area, the Table Guild has changed their FEAST to 31 May, A.S. XXI. All else remains the same. Starting time is 2pm, site is 10205 Powderhouse Road. The theme is a modified Scandinavian Smorgasbord. This is a WET SITE. Please bring your own drinks and feasting gear, if you wish to eat. We are trying something different with this revel: If you come just to visit, listen to, and/or participate in the Bardic Quest, etc., THERE IS NO SITE FEE!! However, if you wish to eat, the FEAST FEE is \$3.50 per person, regardless of age. We assure all who partake of this feast that they will not leave the Shire hungry!!

FROM YOUR TREASURER:

Effective Immediately Shire Policy regarding Site Fees will be: The Autocrat will turn over the expense listing and all fees collected to the Treasurer. The Treasurer can then reimburse the Autocrat for expenses incurred.

"Each and every autocrat of any event sponsored by your group must submit a report on finances of that event. This report must be received within 30 days of the event.

Event accounting can be handled in one of two ways. Your autocrat can have the reservation checks made payable to him or her, pay the event's expenses from this money, and turn in the profit to you with the event report. Or, if your group prefers, reservation checks can be made payable to the group, be deposited into the group's bank account, and the autocrat can request money as needed."

EXPLANATIONS:

PROGRESSIVE THREE PART MELEES:
 These melees are in three parts and all casualties sustained are carried over into the next mealee.

1. Storm the walls
2. Take the treasure
3. Get out of Dodge!

The team that compleats all three with the most survivors is judged the winner (or comes the closest to compleating all three).

RESURRECTION BATTLE:

This one will be the same setup as last year but I will make the cross country trek more difficult. This is a broken field (or hill) mealee and each side will have a defensible fortress!

BAR ROOM BRAWL:

This is a humorous scenario that involves two rival groups of fighters. The setting is a bar. The argument seems to revolve around some insult or another...

QUEST:

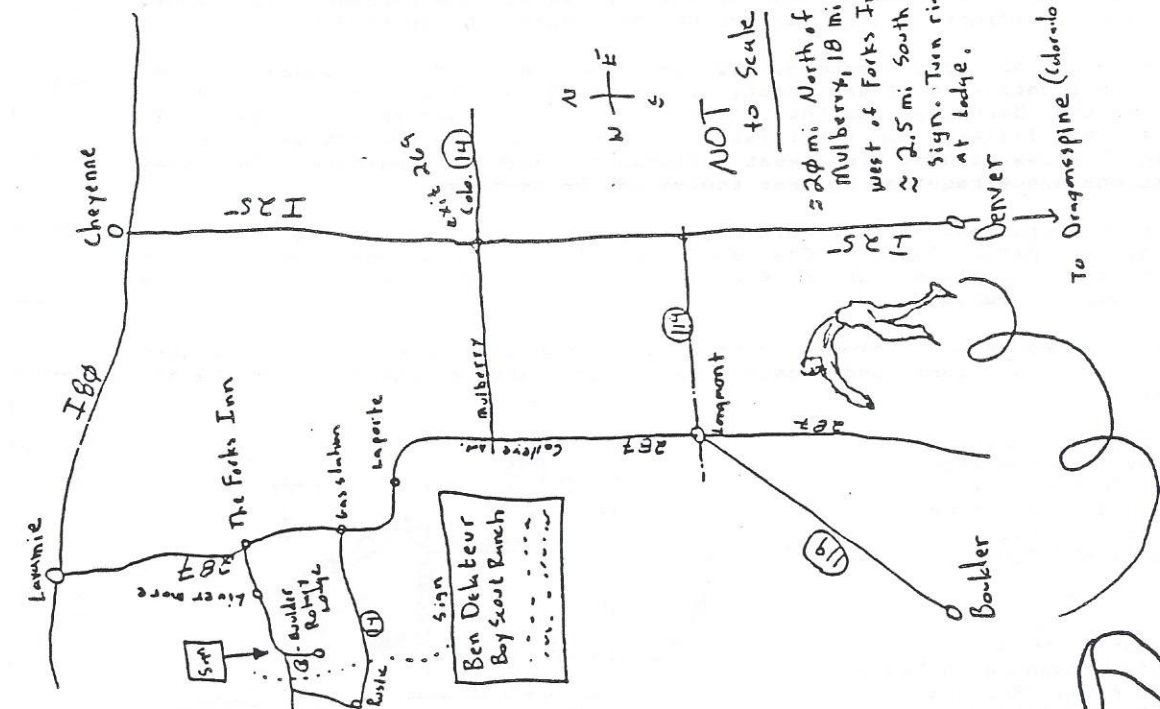

There will be various un-announced competitions as the autocrat sees fit throughout the weekend. Come and have fun!

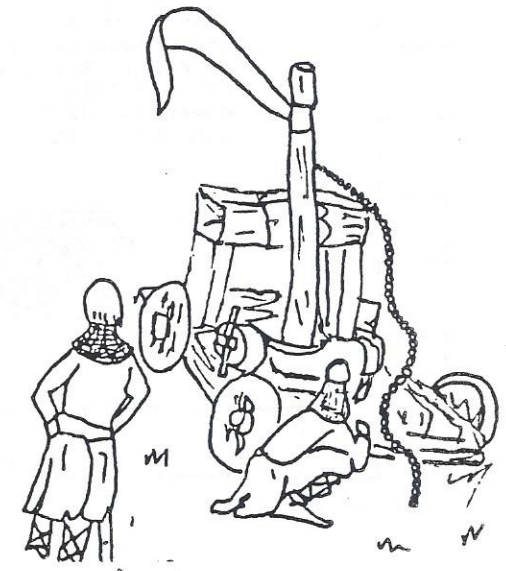

Outlands Crown Tourney

Also for their Majesties' enjoyment during the feast, entertainment is planned. If you wish to perform, please contact the Main Autocrat before May 31st.

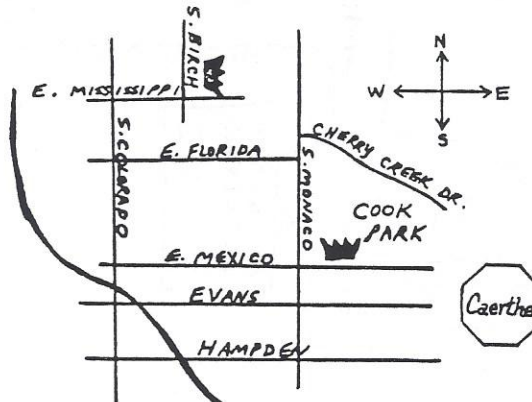
Feast price is \$10 for members, \$12 for non-members. This includes site fee. For those not partaking of the feast, site fee is \$3. Please send reservations payable to the Barony of Caerthe to the Feast Autocrat before May 31st. The feast will be limited to the first 100 reservations, so contact us as soon as possible. Those wishing to feast together should indicate on their reservations space required so that tables can be reserved.

On Sunday a Tournament will be held, again at Cook Park. This will possibly be to select the First Queen's Champion. Details will be in next month's issue. Presentations to their Majesties of regalia or gifts from the populace will be made at Court on Sunday.

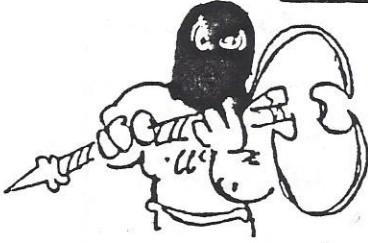

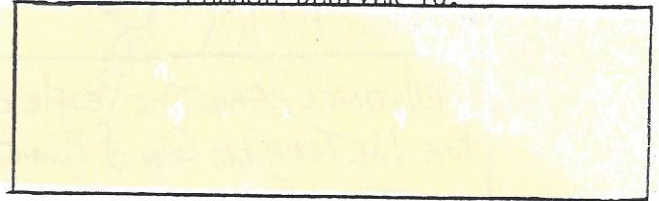

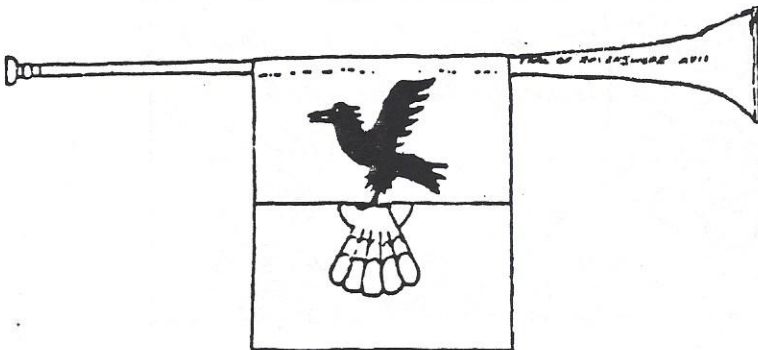


RATAFIA CAKES
