
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

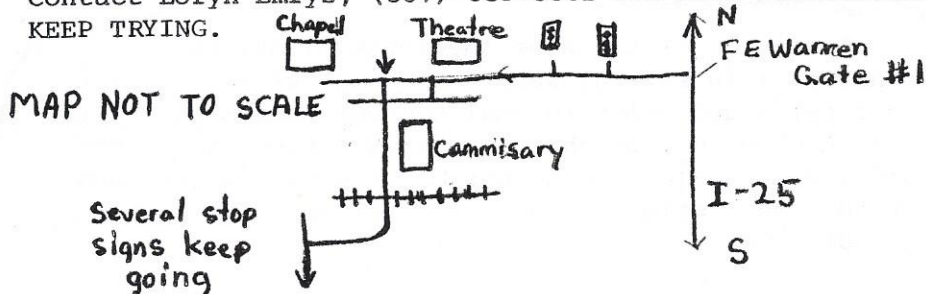
Tourney: Frontier Mall, 12 Noon

The tourney will begin at Cheyenne's Frontier Mall at 12 noon. 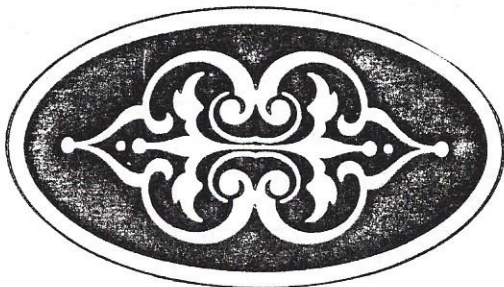

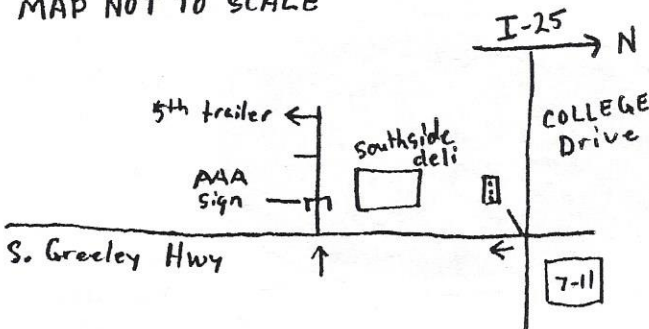
