## From the New Chronicler:

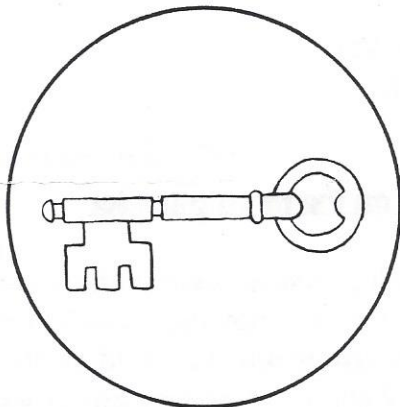

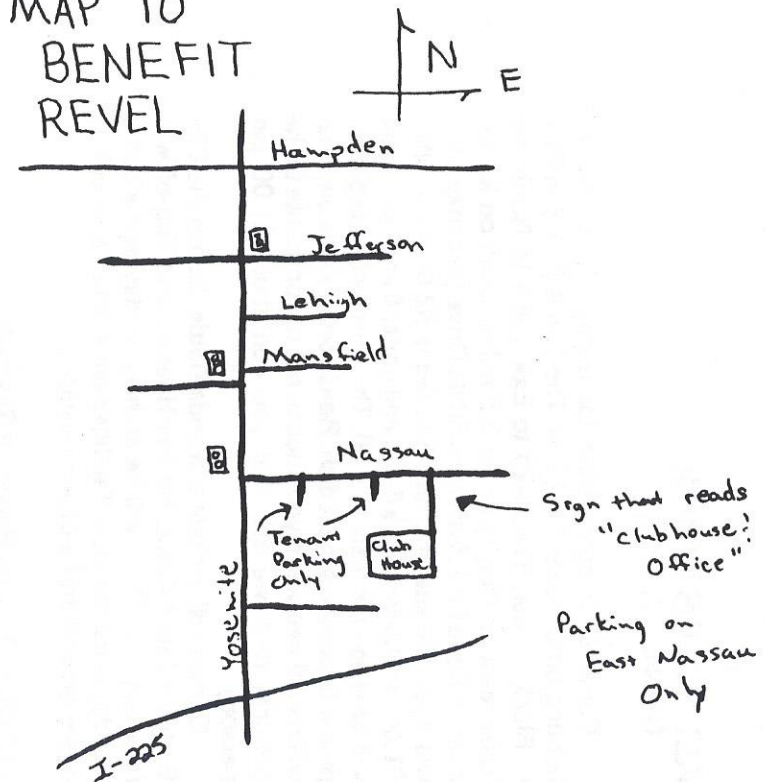

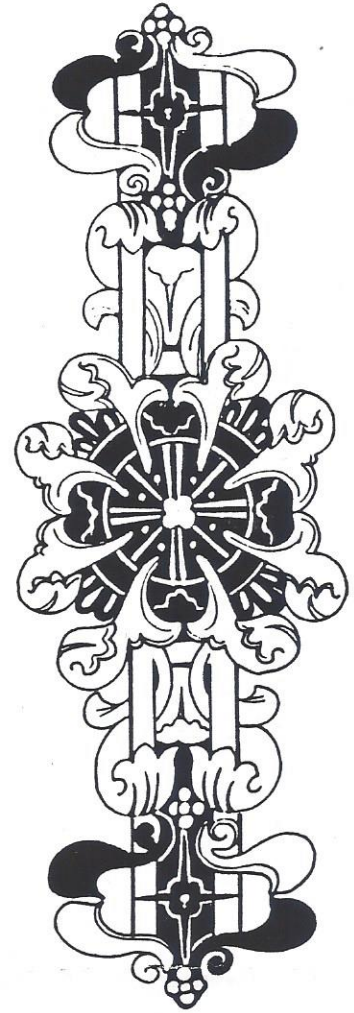
## ALL SOULS REVEL

The Shire of Aarquelle is proud to host the Coronation of the new King and Queen of the Outlands on November 3rd and 4th, 1990.

The site will be the VFW Hall in Pueblo West. The address is 127 East Spaulding. It can be seen next to Highway 50 West about 5 miles from the I-25 turnoff. This is a VFW Hall and Tavern and must be a dry site. No alcoholic beverages may be brought onto site or feast hall. However, you will be able to purchase drinks from the VFW bar for consumption during the feast. No camping allowed on the main site, but a KOA campground, with tent sites, showers and full facilities, is located North on McCulloch about two miles from the VFW Hall. In case of inclement weather, the tourneys will be held at the Pueblo West Middle School.

Crash and camping space is available with Lady Phyllis Meisterssohn and with Lord Seley. There is the Pueblo West Inn within walking distance as well as a Loaf and Jug nearby. Less expensive Inns and other rapid taverns are located near the I-25 and Highway 50 interchange. Bring your own lunch. Directions and maps to all crash space, camp sites and restaurants will be available at the VFW Hall main gate. Reservations, please, on the crash sites.

Site fee will be \$4.00 per person. Children under 12 will be half price. The feast will be at least 5 courses Autocrated by Lady Phyllis. The feast fee will be \$12.00 per person and reservations must be made and paid in advance to Lord Seley by October 19th. Feast hall is limited to 200. Any space available after October 19th will be charged \$20.00 per person. Reserve early to be assured of a space. Royalty will be gratis. 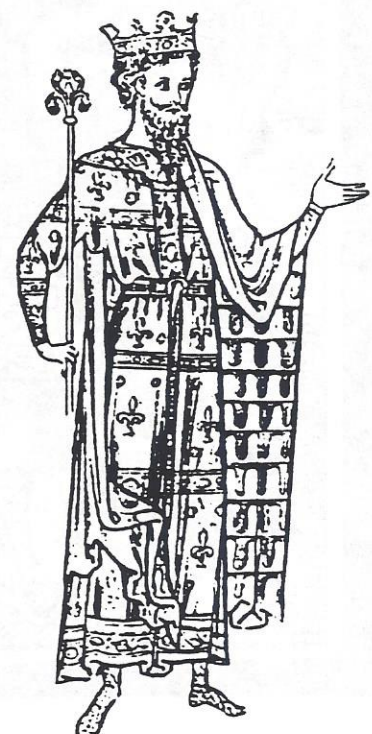
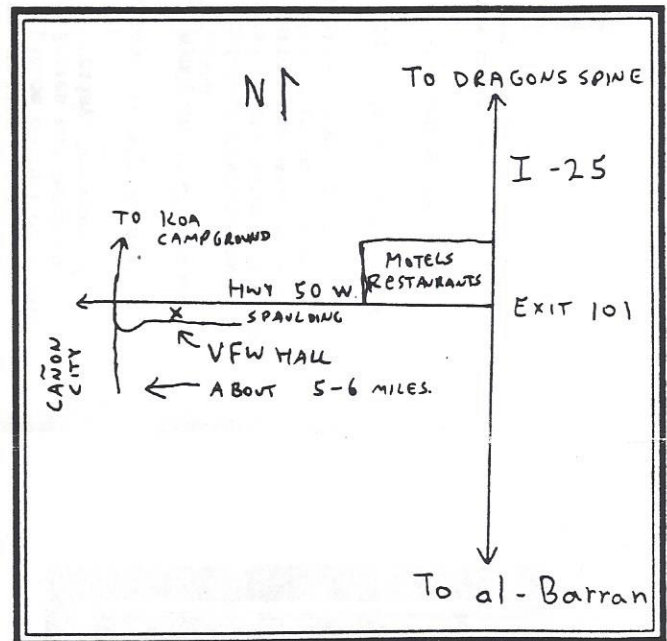

# Caerthan Arts + Sciences Prize Tourney November 17

Subject to last minute necessary changes to be posted at the site, these are the rules for the Caerthan Arts and Sciences Prize Tourney. Anyone may enter. Anyone may win. If the overall champion is not a Caerthan, (that is, claiming Caerthan citizenship,) then the highest scoring Caerthan will be named Baronial Champion. Entrants under 16 may choose to enter either the children's or adult's competition. Unreworked entries which have taken a First are not eligible for the competition but are eligible and requested for the Display Area. Items in Display are eligible for both the Judge's and People's Choice Prizes.

Written works of 10 pages of text must be in my hands by 8 am Monday, November 5. They may be hand-delivered to myself or Don Jean-Eric, (Don Bjarg) at any event.

Entries will be anonymous.

Documentation shall consist of a typed or neatly printed. 5X7 card or half sheet of paper with the following information in this order:

- 1) BRIEF description of entry, time, place and culture.
- 2) Reproduction or representation? (copy of one piece or original based on several examples.) Reproductions require one clear picture of the original.
- 3) Brief description of materials and techniques used and reasons for modern substitutions, if any. Time, expense and toxicity are all valid reasons.
- 4) What help, including use of a kit did you receive and what modifications, if any, were made.

Entries involving recipes shall have a copy of the original and a copy of the one actually used attached. There is a large kitchen but be prepared to work around some cooking classes. If your entry **MUST** be cooked on the premises, please contact me **FIRST**.

I am still looking for Staff, Judges, Prizes and Teachers. Judges are requested to attend a meeting on Friday, November 16 at 7 pm at 2562 Grape St.

To speed the registration process, please contact me after November 5 to be assigned a random number.

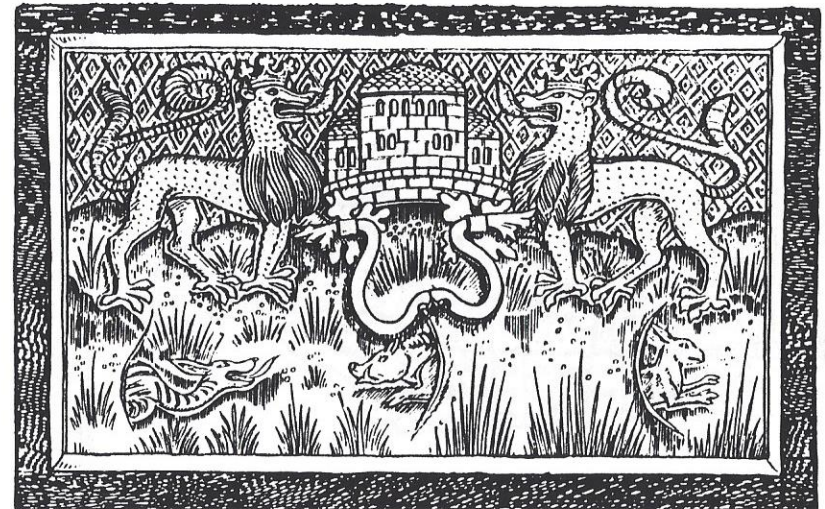

# Hunter's Feast

## November 24 - 25

The hunters of Windkeep have been successful. They invite all gentles to join their celebration in the beautiful Hynds Lodge, in the Medicine Bow National Forest, west of Cheyenne. The site will open at 9:00 am Nov. 24th and they have planned fun for all with a heavy weapons tournament and woods melee as well as an ambush escort fencing tourney. Other tournaments may be devised as time, weather and the number of entrants permit. Additionally, there will be an Arts & Sciences competition (categories for both larges and smalls) and a boffer tourney. There will also be a challenging archery tournament.

A modest fee of \$15.00 (smalls half) covers the entire weekend. There will be a feast of wild game in the lodge on Saturday following the tourneys, and other food will be available throughout the weekend. Lodging on site is available and encouraged. There are beds available on a first-come, first-serve basis, but please bring appropriate sleeping furs, bags, or whatever. Limited floor space is also available. When you make reservations, please let the Autocrat know if you will require beds. Merchants are encouraged, but please contact Autocrat in advance for space.

There are still servers and entertainers being sought, and the Autocrat has allowed that anyone who entertains at the feast or helps in the kitchen will enjoy the weekend free of fees. Also, anyone willing to donate game to the feast will enjoy a fee adjustment (or negation), but meat must be in the Feastocrats hands by Nov. 1st. Please contact the Feastocrat in advance to make arrangements.

There are only two hard, fast rules on this site: 1) There can be no pets due to the wildlife that is living around the lodge, and 2) The site is discreetly wet. Alcohol may only be consumed in the lodge the evening of the feast -- period containers please, and you must take them home with you. Rangers will be on site to enforce these rules.

The number of feasters is restricted to the first 100 reservations, as that is all the lodge will seat. If you wish to make reservations after Nov. 1st please contact the Feastocrat to determine availability. Written confirmation will be sent to those making advance reservations.

There will be many items for raffle, the proceeds going to serve Kingdom and shire needs.

Should Royalty attend and so wish, Court will be held.

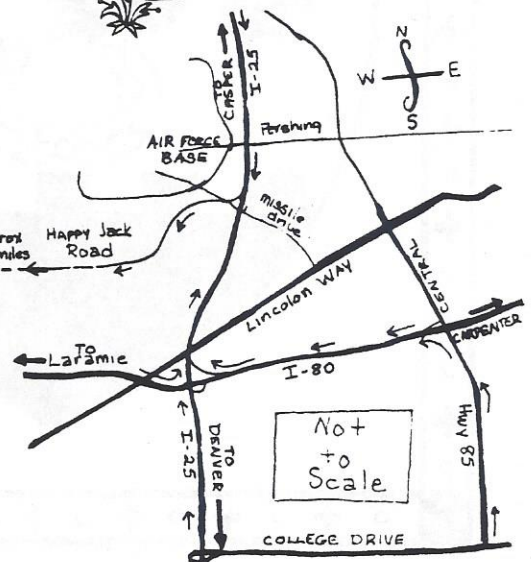

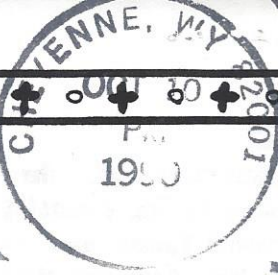
