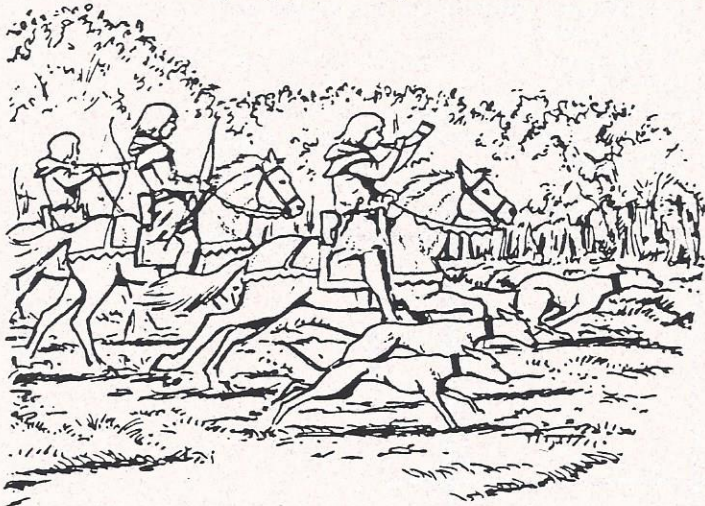
## **Hunter's Feast III** 26 October 1991



The Shire of Windkeep again invites the populace of the Outlands to share in their Hunter's Feast, to be held this year on October 26 1991 at the First Christian Church, 27th St and Carey, Cheyenne Wyoming. The menu will consist of the bounties of hunt and harvest. During the day there will be fencing, heavy weapons, and other diversions at Lyons Park (The same area as Crown Tournament). If sufficient people are interested the Autocrat will also arrange for an archery competition to be held. The fee for the event is \$10.00. The Lyons Park site will open at 11:00am with the games beginning soon thereafter. The feast site will open at 5:00pm with the feast to begin at precisely 6:00pm (SCA time). Dancing and other indoor games will be held during and after the feast. Crash space is available for any wishing to stay overnight.

Lady Aldith will be feastocrating again, and offers to adjust feast fees for any gentles who would like to donate from their own harvest. Contact Lady Aldith if you would like to donate to the feast. Anyone who wishes to serve in any capacity will also have fees adjusted. 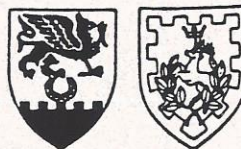

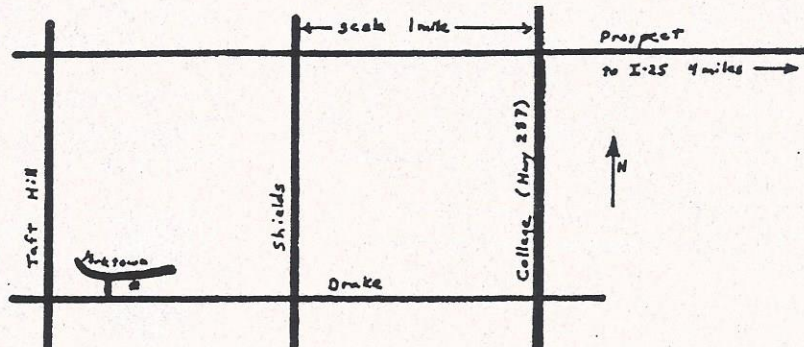

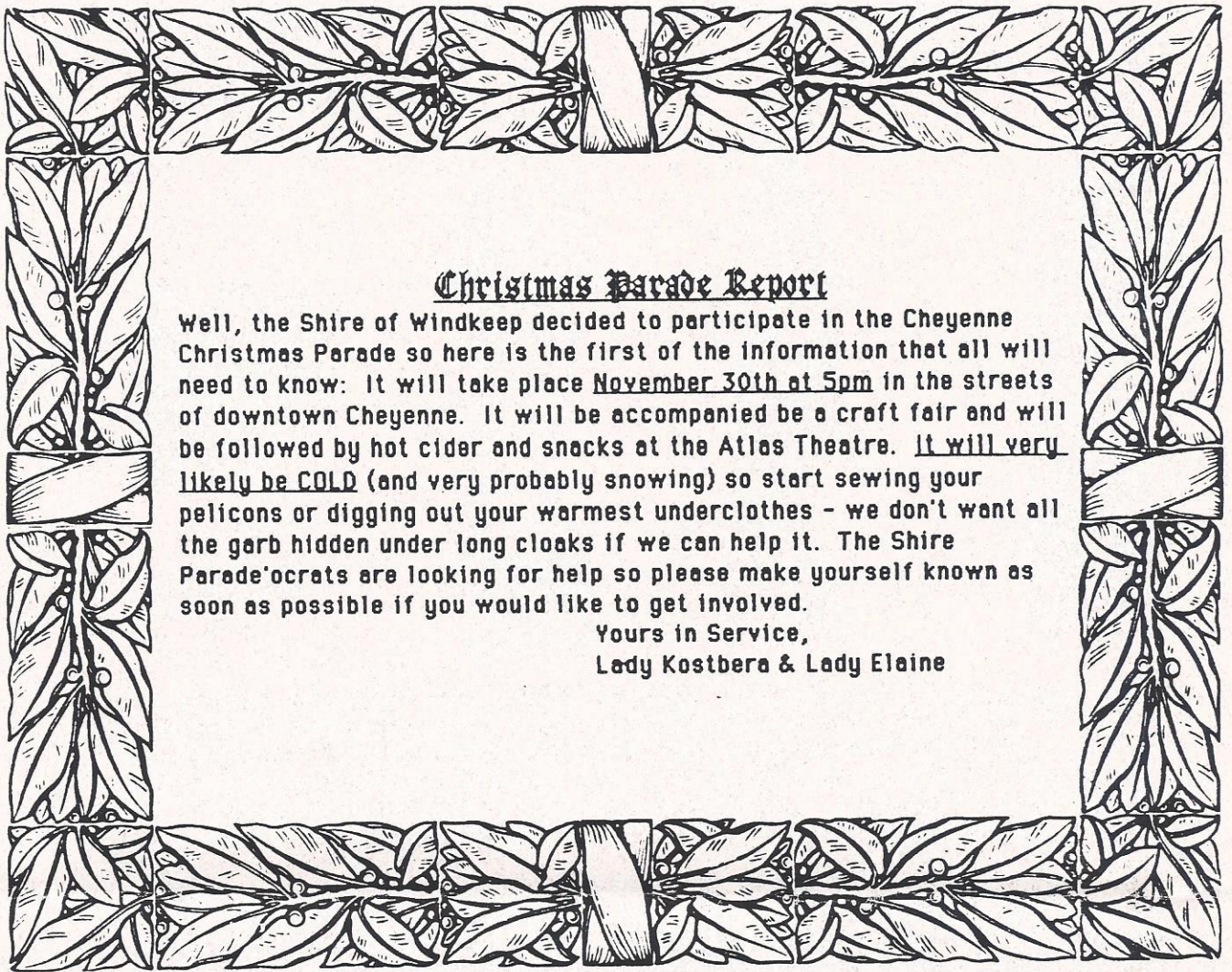
Items that have won a first place in a category (or higher) at an Outlands Kingdom Arts & Sciences competition are welcome to be displayed, but they will not compete.

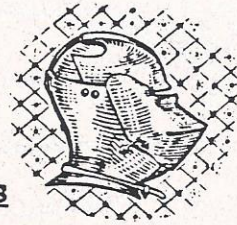
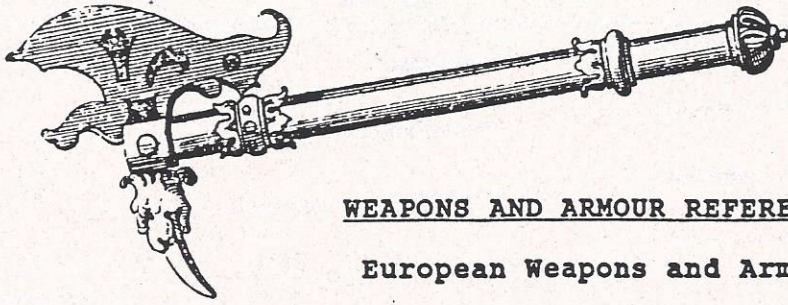
### Don't know what to wear to Caerthen Twelfth Night?

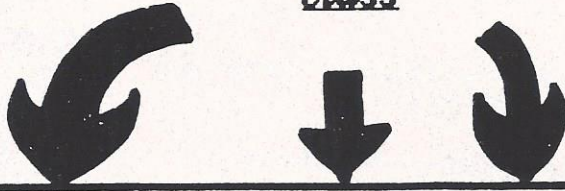
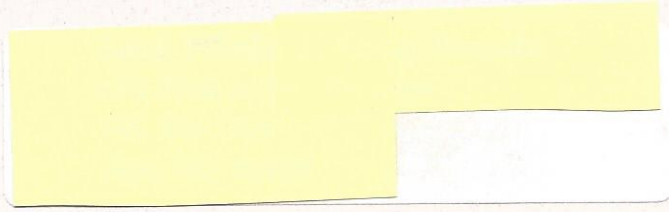

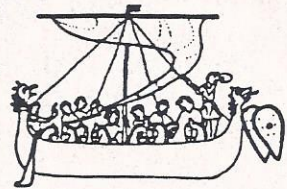
