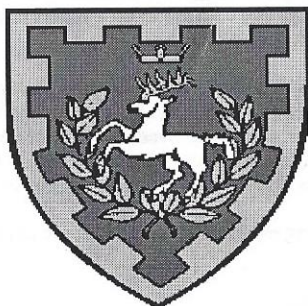
Monday is Archery Practice at Master Rhys and Mistress Aldyth's starting around 5:30 to 6:00 pm.

Greetings Shire,

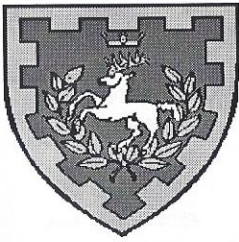

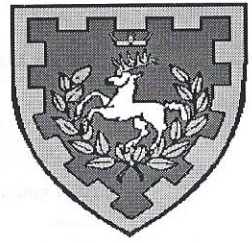

Hail to all, fare you well. Draw you all nigh; the populace of the Known world is invited to attend The Field of Gold Championship Tournament Weekend. This grand and auspicious event is being hosted by the Barony of Caerthe; with the assistance of the past F.O.G Protectors, and the Northern Outlands. The Current Champion, Thl. Gwilmn, sends out a challenge to all who believe themselves equal to the arduous task of showing themselves to be highly skilled in the Arts of Fighting and War; as well as, the Arts and Sciences. You will be challenged in the areas of Heavy Weapons, Fencing, Archery, and, Bardic or Arts and Sciences.

You must proclaim yourself at the Grand Processional on Saturday Morning.

Honour, Fame, and, Glory await the next "Lord High Protector of the Field of Gold", as well as, great prizes and riches. As in the past, the victorious challenger will choose the "Consort of Love and Beauty" both to reign for a year and a day. But, be not dismayed, there will, also, be Champions in each individual area. A Children's Field of Gold Championship in boffer, archery, and either A.& S., or, Bardic will be offered for our beloved children.

Fighting: Each of the three Baronies; Caerthe, Dragonsspine, and, Unser Hafen, will sponsor one Heavy weapons tournament, one Rapier Tournament, and one Archery Tournament. Two of each of these tournaments will be held on Saturday, and one each on Sunday. Sir Kronos plans a Torchlight Tournament after the Bardic challenge on Saturday night. There will be a Boffer tournament, run by Lord Patric on Saturday in the cool afternoon. Prizes will be awarded for the traditional categories. We hope to have bocce ball available, as well.

Arts: There will be classes throughout the weekend. Saturday, throughout the sunlight hours, the Field of Gold Arts and Sciences competition will take place, and, Saturday after sunset, the Field of Gold Bardic Challenge will enliven the nighttime. The Children's Bardic will take place after feast on Saturday evening. We ask and challenge the mighty musicians, drummers, and dancers the plan a spectacle and celebration for all on Sunday after dark.

The quest will be fast moving and challenging - be prepared to travel to various ports of call to search our treasure. In the last month I have had a few newer members to the SCA stop me just to tell me how incredible life has been since finding the SCA. One gentle told me that it has improved his home life, another that she feel at home for the first time in years. These revelations and campsite confessions have given me cause to reflect on the feelings I had when I had just found the SCA.

At the time I was a member of the Air Force, pulling call every other week and trying to juggle my job and raising kids. I was the president of the Local Boy Scout Council, and chairman of my Church's financial committee but I really never socialized with those people. I kept telling the folks who were asking me to come out to an event that I didn't have time, I had other important things to do. Finally I was coerced into coming out to a demo under the guise of needing some first aid support.

I froze at that event but I had fun, and when the next local event happened, I brought my wife and the kids. I had the greatest time and met the most kind and helpful people I had ever seen. Everyone was ready and willing to answer my questions, introduce me to people I had not yet met, and to top everything off, my wife won the desert competition. I resolved to know more about this group and these people.

I would tell you that my next opportunity and what sold me on the SCA was at a Coronation where I saw Court for the first time, and was spellbound by the pageantry, and was speechless (one of the few times in my life) at the site of the King and Queen in all of their regal beauty, but that would not be true. What sold me was the gentle people in my local shire who took me into their homes and showed me how to dress and act, who didn't criticize when I messed up, who helped me find a name and a home amongst friends who are more like family. I remember saying to one of them, "This is the most incredible thing that has ever happened to me."

Now I find that I am more busy then I ever was before finding the SCA. I help out with archery, go to fighter practice, teach new people how to make things that I learned a lifetime before. I go to Shire business meetings and spend almost every night working on some aspect of my Kingdom office. Within all that I can't remember the last time I said "I don't have time," and my life has never been happier, surrounded by my SCA family.
