Mistress Rosalind of Wellmark will host a donation lunch.

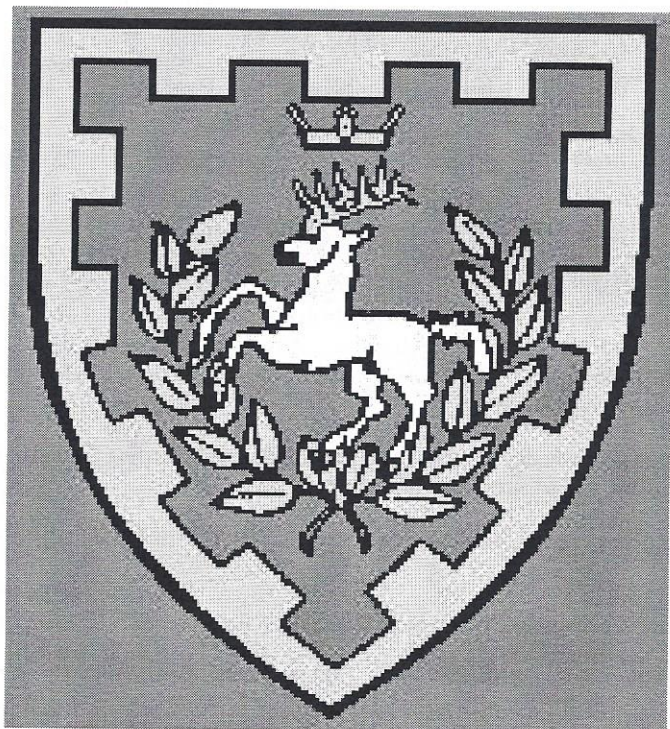

There will be a demo of the SCA at the International Longs Peak Scottish Highland Games Festival, in Estes Park, Colorado. (<http://www.scotfest.com>). This demo will be set up and ready to go on Thursday, September 6th, by noon. The SCA has been asked to participate in the area of the Historical Re-enactment Camp. We will be set up in the usual place, near the lake. Hours for the demo will be; 12noon to 5pm on Thursday, 9am to 5pm on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. This demo is the result of a long-standing relationship that the SCA has had with the festival, and is a fun event to attend. Any good gentles that are not planning on attending the Outlands Crown Tournament, this same weekend, are invited to come and talk about the SCA, and demonstrate your particular favorite arts and sciences. Heavy Weapons Fighting and Fencing are favorites with the festival goers. Our cousins from Calontir, and Ansteorra will be joining us again this year, as may others from the KnownWorld. Camping at the demo site will be for Period tents only, but there is camping available for mundane tents and RVs. It is most important to RSVP with the autocrat no later than SUNDAY MORNING, AUGUST 19th. RSVP is important for tallying up the needed Day Passes, Parking Passes, RV Parking Passes, as well as a good idea of what to report to the Festival Organizers for tent count.

Please contact the autocrat: Lady Althea ni Cullaugh with a skill you wish to demonstrate, or if you would like to be a greeter and talk about the SCA with the public. All arts and sciences are welcome, and any help with set up or tear down is extremely needed. With the high winds we had last year, we did not get to set up the candle making demo, which was a big disappointment to all. Demos that require delicate art work, such as fine fiber arts, calligraphy and illumination, musical instruments, and hand-sewing materials will need to be set up inside Period Tents. All who wish to attend, are encouraged to pack as much of their supplies and artwork into plastic tubs. This will protect from any inclement weather, as we only have tents to protect us! Remember; you can sign up for one day only, or all four days if you wish. You can camp if you like, but you don't have to. Shifts are desirable, so that each SCA volunteer may walk around and see the festival at some point during the day.

One of each white, red and black. Lords, it will be your duty to "earn" the garters from the ladies over the course of the day.
